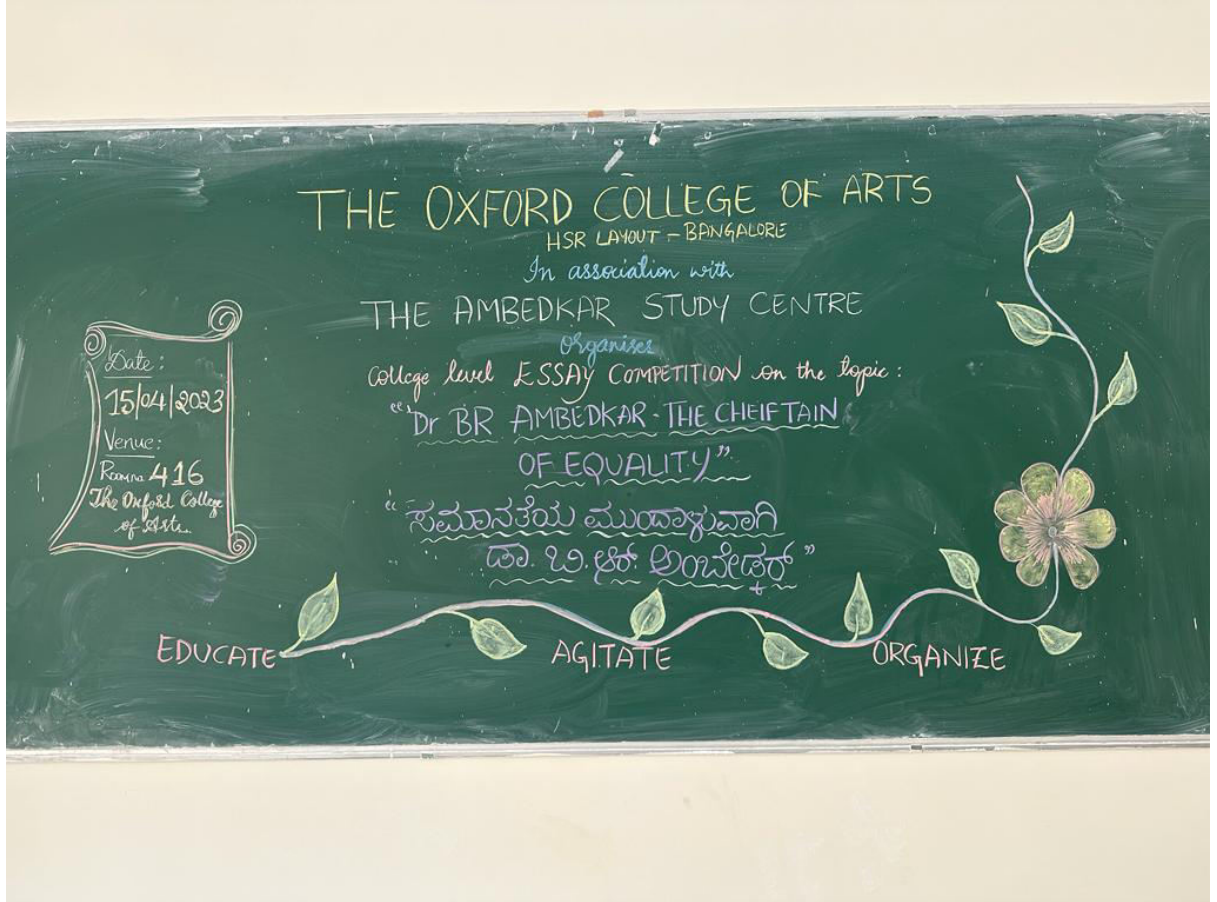


CELEBRATION OF DR. B R AMBEDKAR JAYANTI
