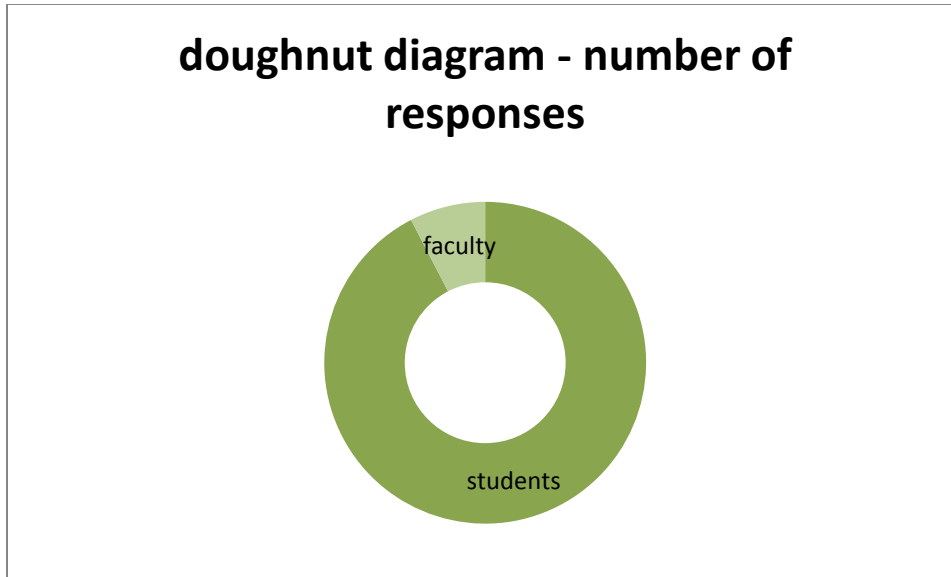


Figure1: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

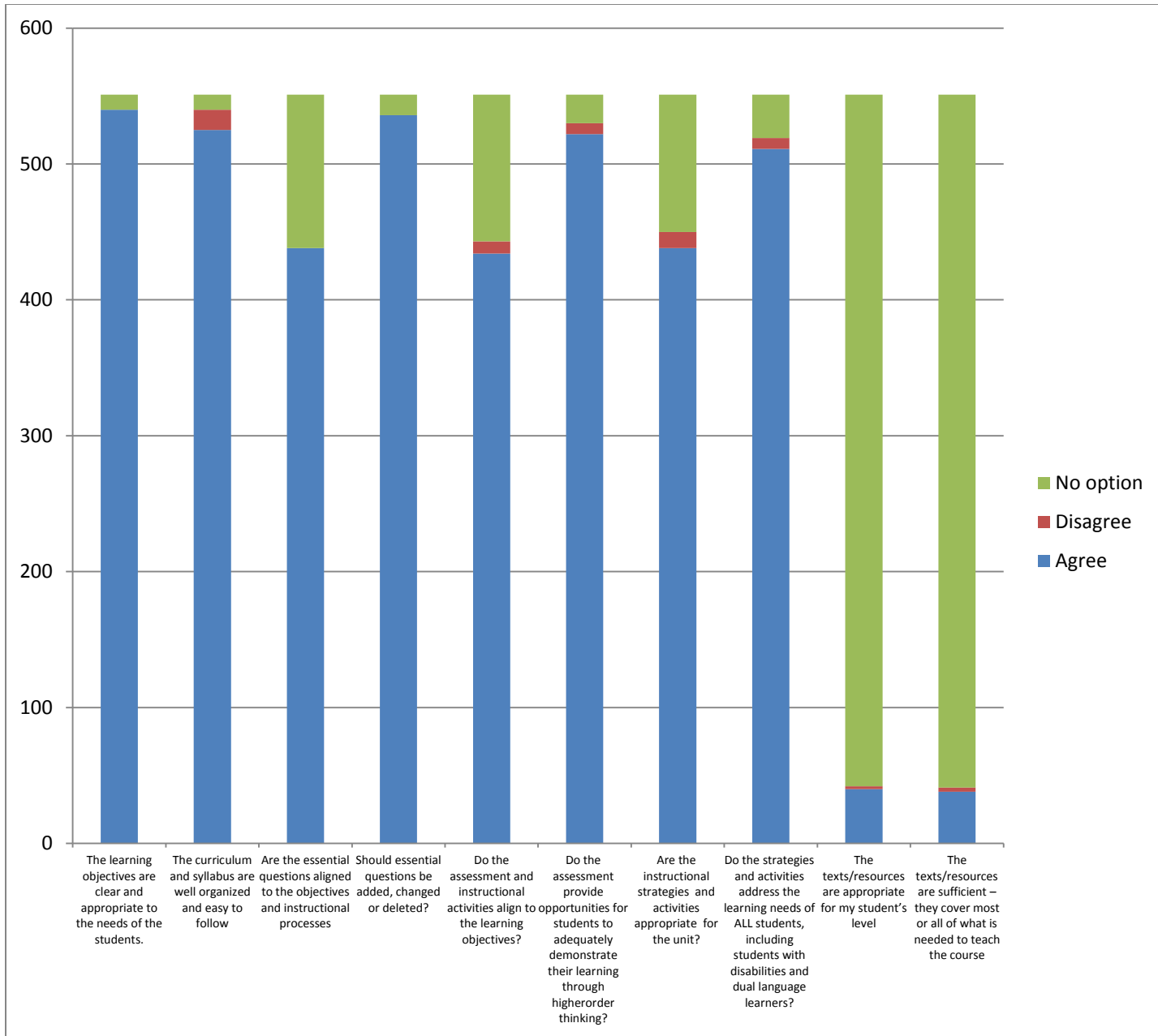


Figure2: stacked column- reflects responses

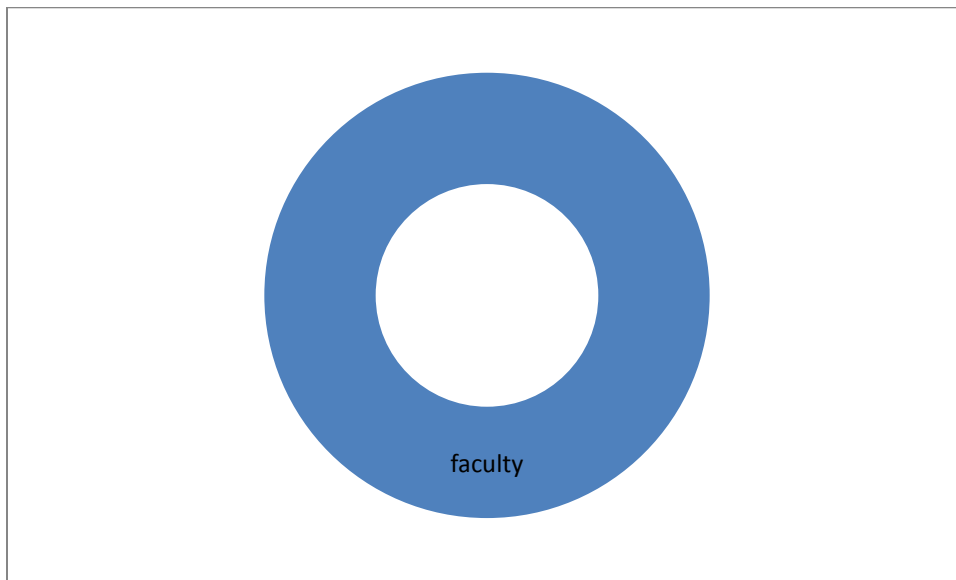


Figure3: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

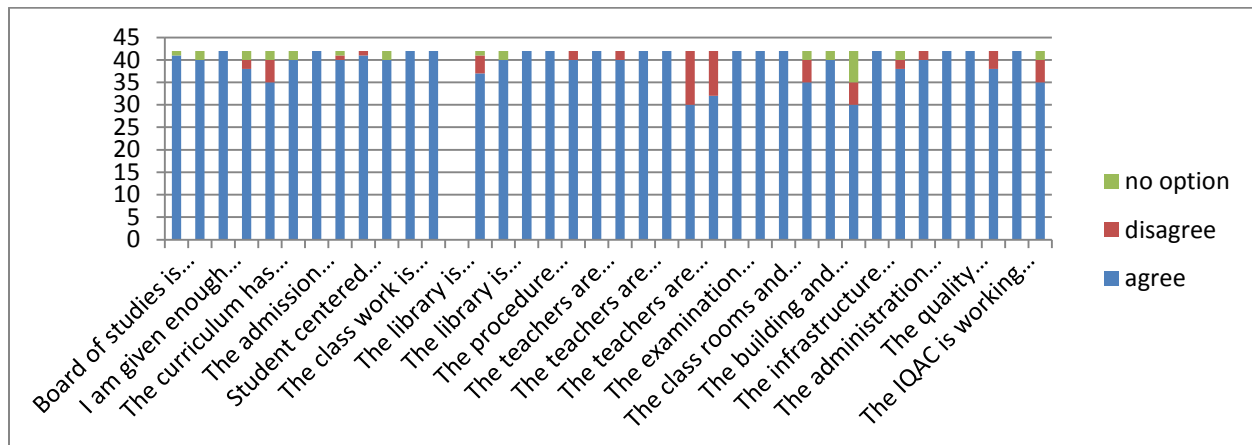


Figure 4: stacked column- reflects responses

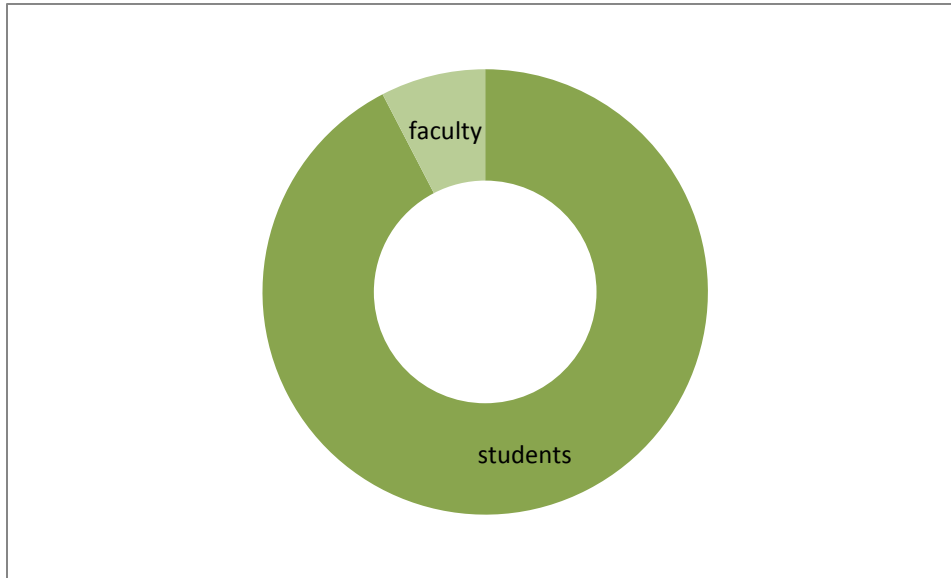


Figure5: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

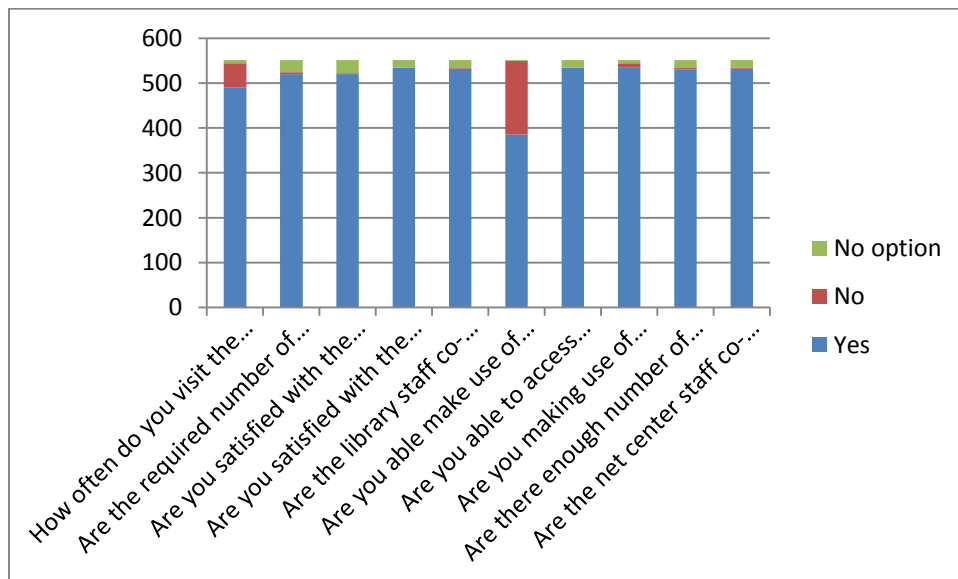


Figure 6: stacked column- reflects responses

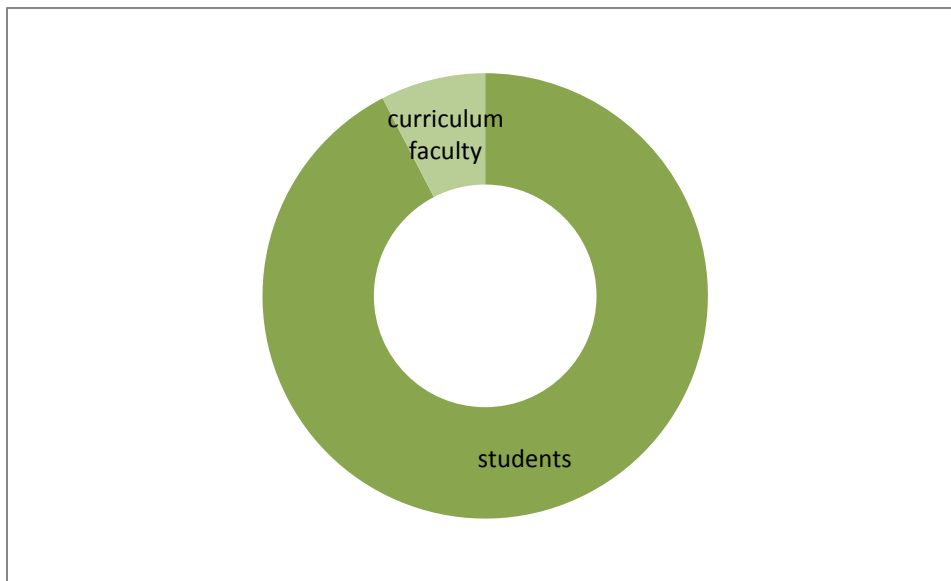


Figure7: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

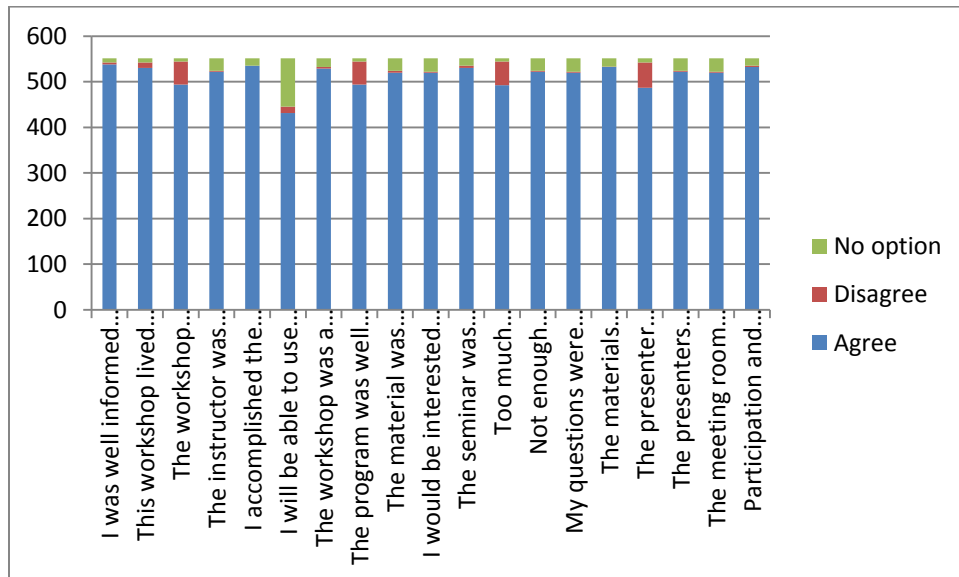


Figure 8: stacked column- reflects responses

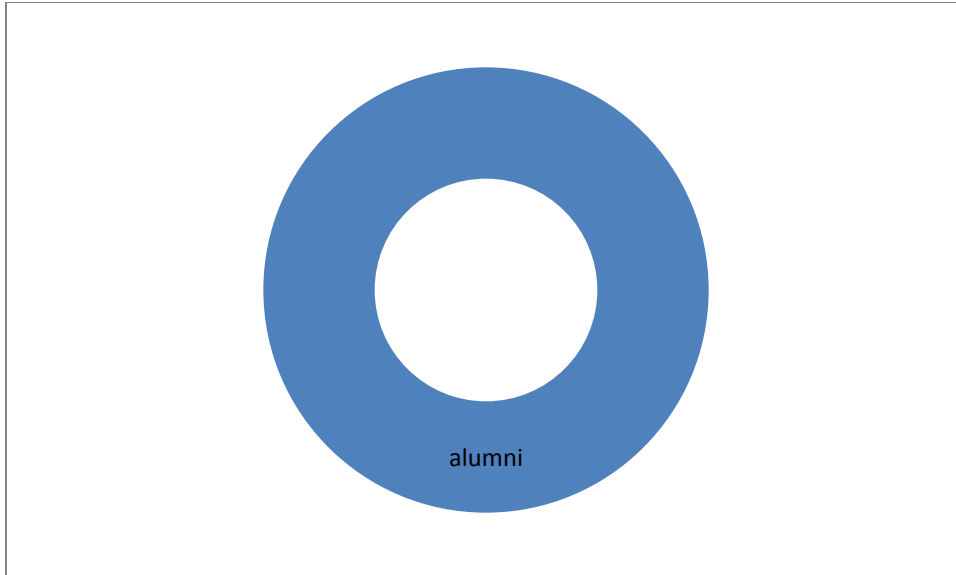


Figure 9: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

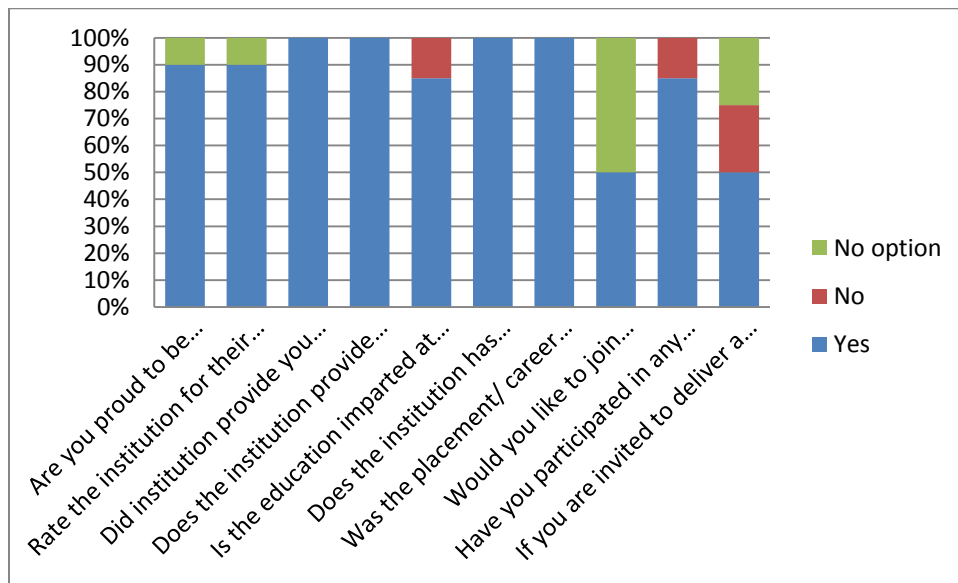


Figure 10: stacked column- reflects responses

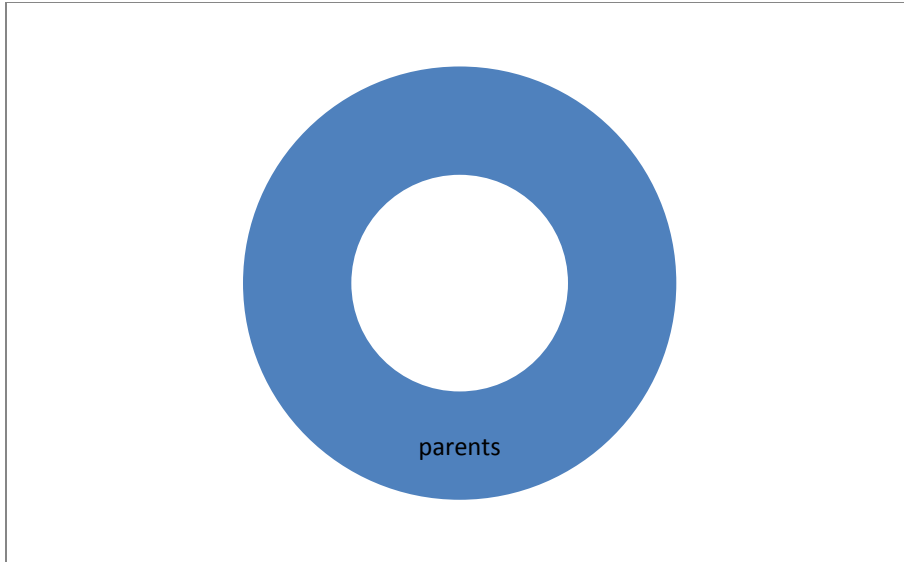


Figure 11: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

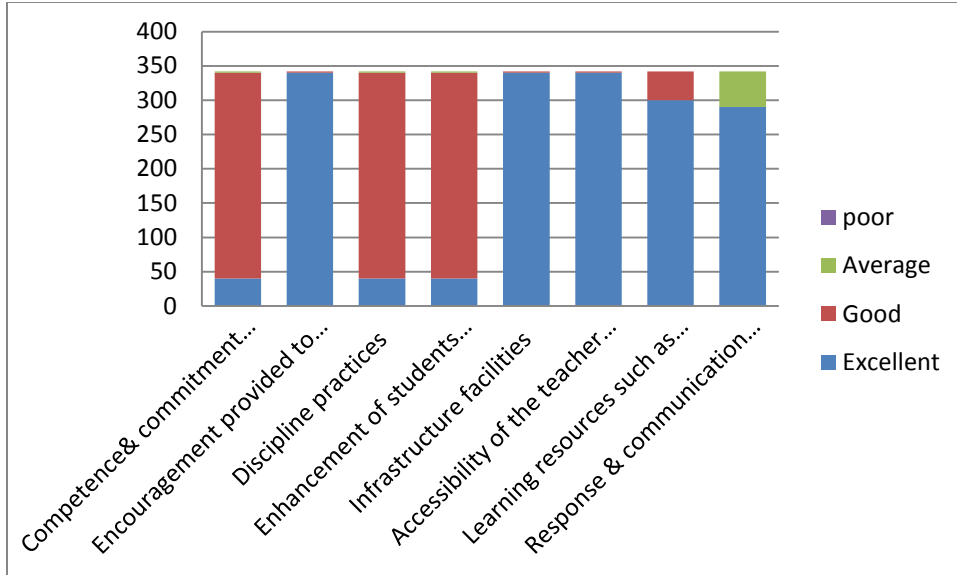


Figure 12: stacked column- reflects responses

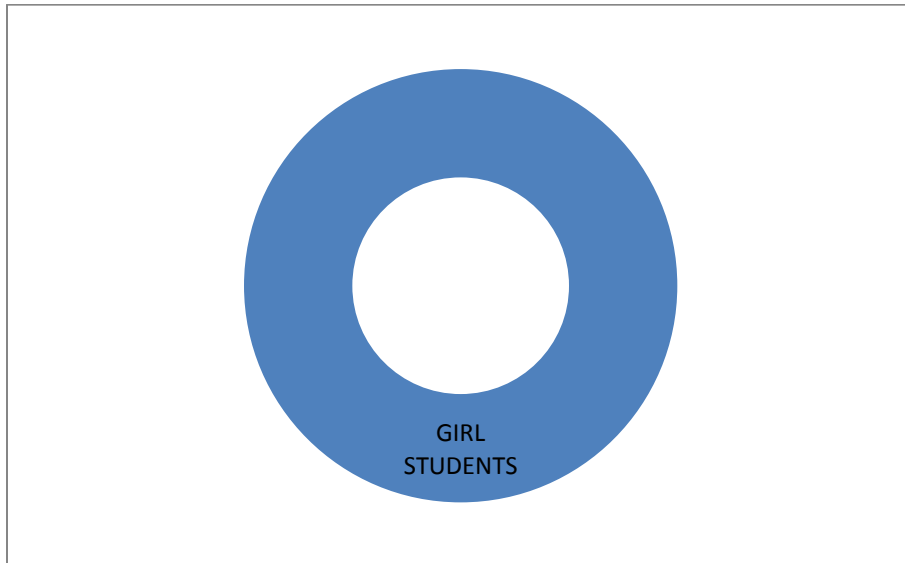


Figure 13: Doughnut Diagram - number of responses

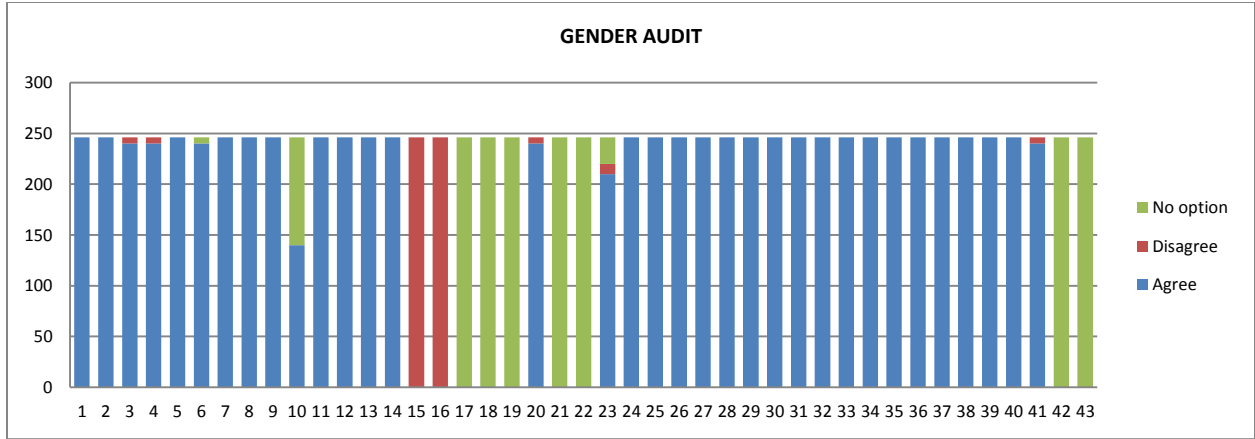


Figure 14: stacked column- reflects responses
