CAREER OPTIONS AFTER COMPLETING B. PHARM OR M. PHARM

1. Teaching:
 - M Pharm pass out students can get as assistant professor job in pharmacy degree colleges.
 - **Assistant Professor Scale: Starting Salary**
 - **Rs. 43000 to 44000** (As per 15600 – 39100 AGP – 6000) per month
2. Pharmacist:
 - M Pharm, Ph.D plus 5 years of experience get
 - as associate professor job in pharmacy degree colleges.
 - **Associate professor Salary: Starting Salary**
3. Quality Assurance Health Manager:
 - **Rs. 78000 to 80000** (As per 37400 – 67000 AGP 9000) per month


4. Medical Transcription - The B Pharm graduate can work with medical practitioners to maintain the patient treatment history, the drug to which he/she is allergic etc.



5. Analytical Chemist or Quality Control Manager - The pharmacy graduate can play a crucial role in maintaining product quality. The drug and the Cosmetics Act (1945), Rules 71(1) and 76(1) says that the manufacturing activity should be taken up under the supervision of a technical man whose qualification should be B Pharm, B Sc, B Tech in medicine with Bio-Chemistry.




4. **Sales and Marketing:** Ambitious students with pleasant personality and good communication skills can opt for the job of Medical Sales Representative. The companies prefer pharmacy graduates for this job, as they have a good knowledge about the drug molecules, their therapeutic effects and the drug - drug interactions.

5. **Clinical Research:** B Pharm/ M Pharm degree holders can take up career in clinical research. The human testing phase is called the clinical trial. A pharmacist can work as clinical research associate or clinical pharmacist and can rise to the position of project manager. The clinical research associate plays an important role of monitoring and supervising the conduct of clinical trials, which are conducted in healthy human volunteers. They have to see that the trials meet the international guidelines and the national regulatory requirements.




6. **Data Manager:** A pharmacist can seek employment as "Data Manager" to store the data in the computer and process it using software developed for the purpose.




7. **Regulatory Manager:** A pharmacy graduate can work as "Regulatory Manager" (RM) in company and contract research organization. As an RM he has to oversee regulatory documentation such as "IND" trial approval permission, marketing approval permission etc.




8. **Career in Regulatory bodies:** A Pharmacist can be absorbed in the Regulatory bodies like Food and Drug Administration. Pharmacist having experience in clinical trial centers can also be employed as Inspector to inspect the clinical trial process. For these positions a Pharmacist needs to appear and pass the MPPSC examination.




9. **Researcher:** In their previous branch, all the B Pharm graduates can opt for post graduate diploma / programmes in Biotechnology.



10. **The B Pharm Science programme is considered as a paramedical programme. The B Pharm Science graduates can continue work in hospitals as hospital pharmacist or community pharmacist.**



11. **Since they have a good knowledge of therapeutic effect of drugs and that of drug - drug interaction, they are more suitable for a job in clinical research. They can opt for the post of clinical pharmacist or clinical research associate in a clinical research laboratory.**
