The queries were patiently answered by Mr. GM Sofi Kamal








How was the experience with this webinar? 265 responses

PREAMBLE

The Oxford College of Pharmacy, NSS Committee, IQAC, Bangalore conducted the session on "Menstrual health of female and hygiene for zero profit" for the students. There were totally 60 participants who included faculties and students.

A special virtual session on Menstrual health of female and hygiene for zero profit was organized by NSS Cell, The Oxford College of Pharmacy on 18/09/2021. Research Associate, Vidya R of Global Hunt Foundation, Bangalore and Ms. Roshnee Bhowmick CSR executive conducted a virtual session for the girl students. The virtual session was conducted through MS Teams. She had conducted 90+ talks on Menstrual health of female and hygiene for zero profit. The talk was addressed to female students of The Oxford College of Pharmacy. The entire program was coordinated by Assistant professor Ms R. Nagalakshmi.

Ms. Nagalakshmi R, gave a warm welcome to members of Global Hunt Foundation and the speaker Ms. Roshnee Bhowmick. Global Hunt Foundation has a number of branches across the globe and is a not-for-profit organization, registered under The Indian Companies Act 1956. A session on Menstrual Health and Hygiene Training was conducted by their corporate client Unicharm India. Unicharm India has conducted menstrual hygiene training for girls in various schools/colleges across India, under the CSR initiatives of the company. Unicharm India is a leading Japanese firm in India, existing in the market with the names of Sofy and Mamypoko pants.

The session was very informative for the girls which gave them a comprehensive understanding on the what, why and how of menstruation. It consisted of the meaning of menstruation, developing biological understanding, related social taboos and awareness regarding hygiene practices to be maintained during menstruation. At the end of the session all the queries of the students were satisfied by Ms. Roshnee Bhowmick.






Ms Roshnie Bowmick had been connected by MS Teams and she created awareness among all the ladies present in the gathering. The students assembled ten minutes prior to the talk and maintained social distance as per the Covid-19 guidelines. Speaker spoke about some crucial aspects related to menstruation and to maintain hygiene during menstrual cycle. She gave information regarding different stages of period's right from Menarche to Meno Pause. The talk was very effective, as it gave more importance to how to tackle with Menstrual cycle, What are different sanitary napkins available and also gave insights about how to use them.
