The event was ended with a bonus tips. The event was ended with Q & A session where the participants asked few doubts regarding the Do's and Don'ts.

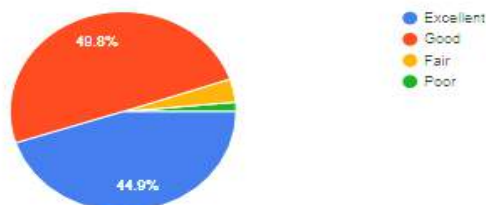
The queries were patiently answered by Mr. GM Sofi Kamal

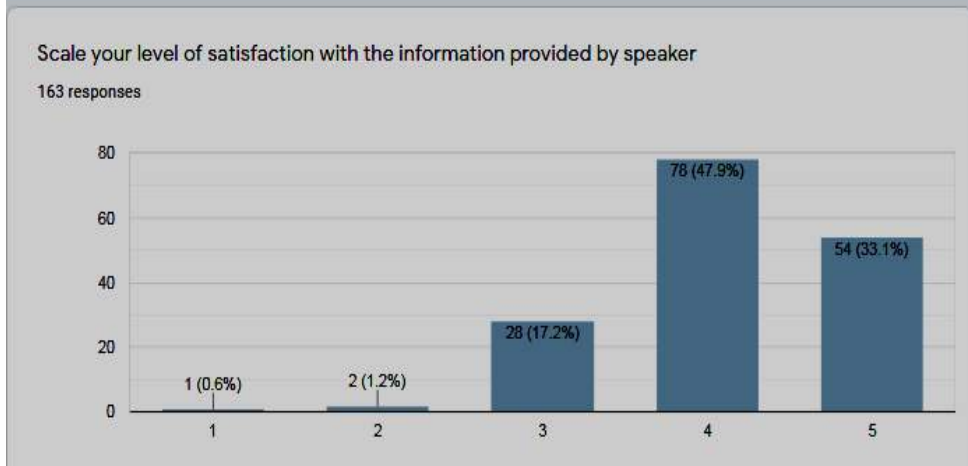
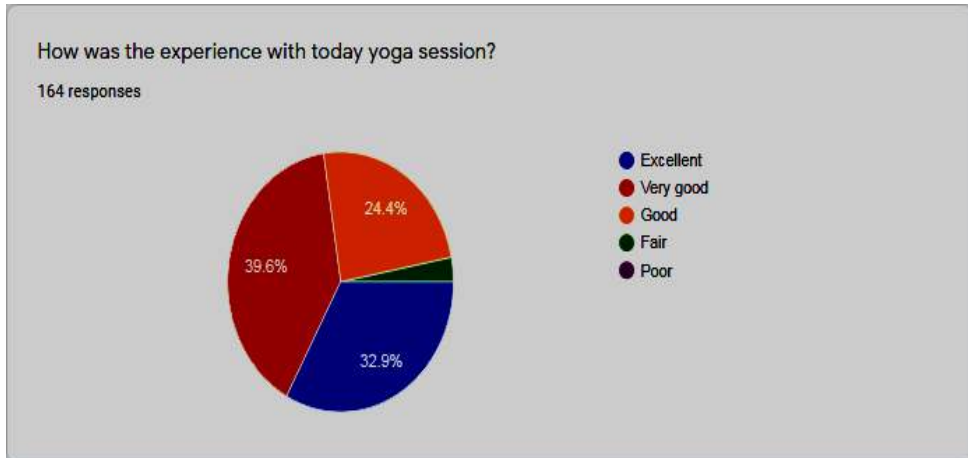
PREAMBLE

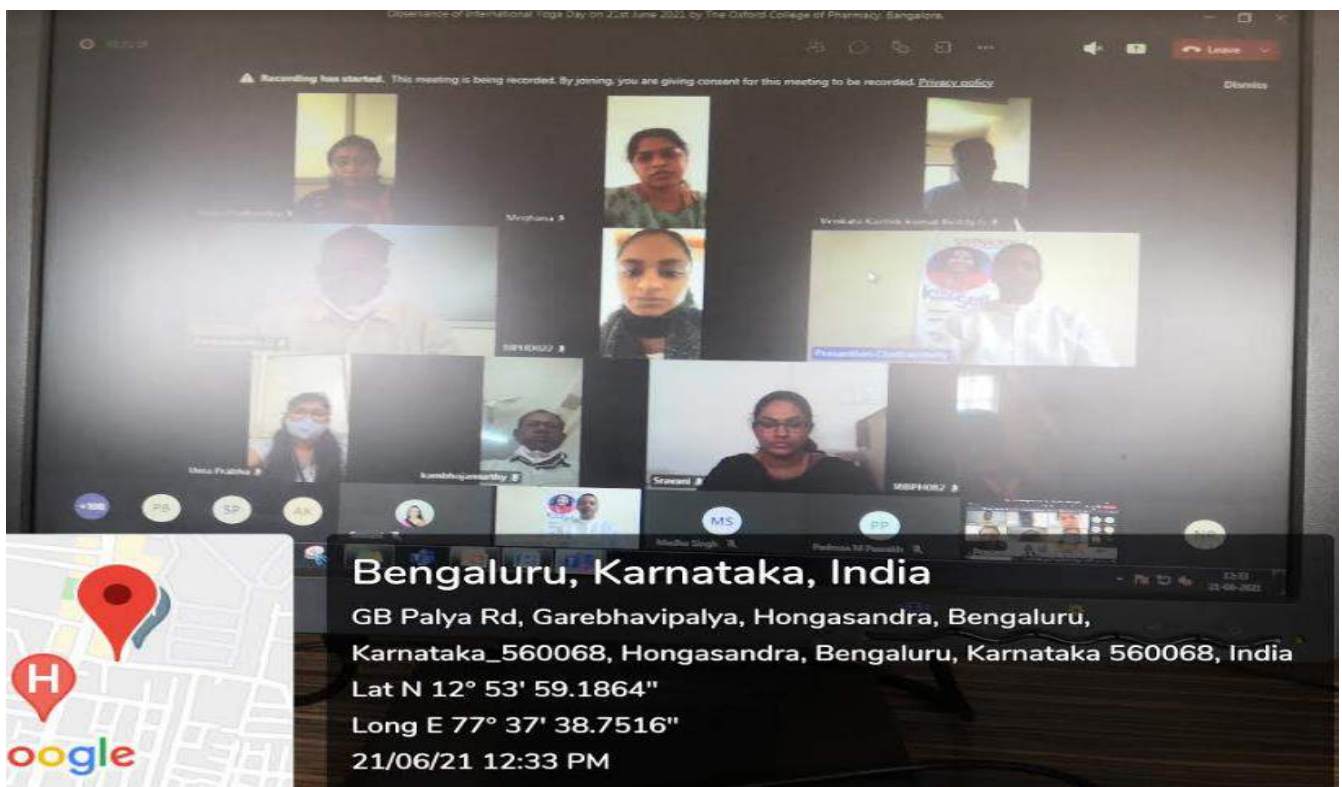
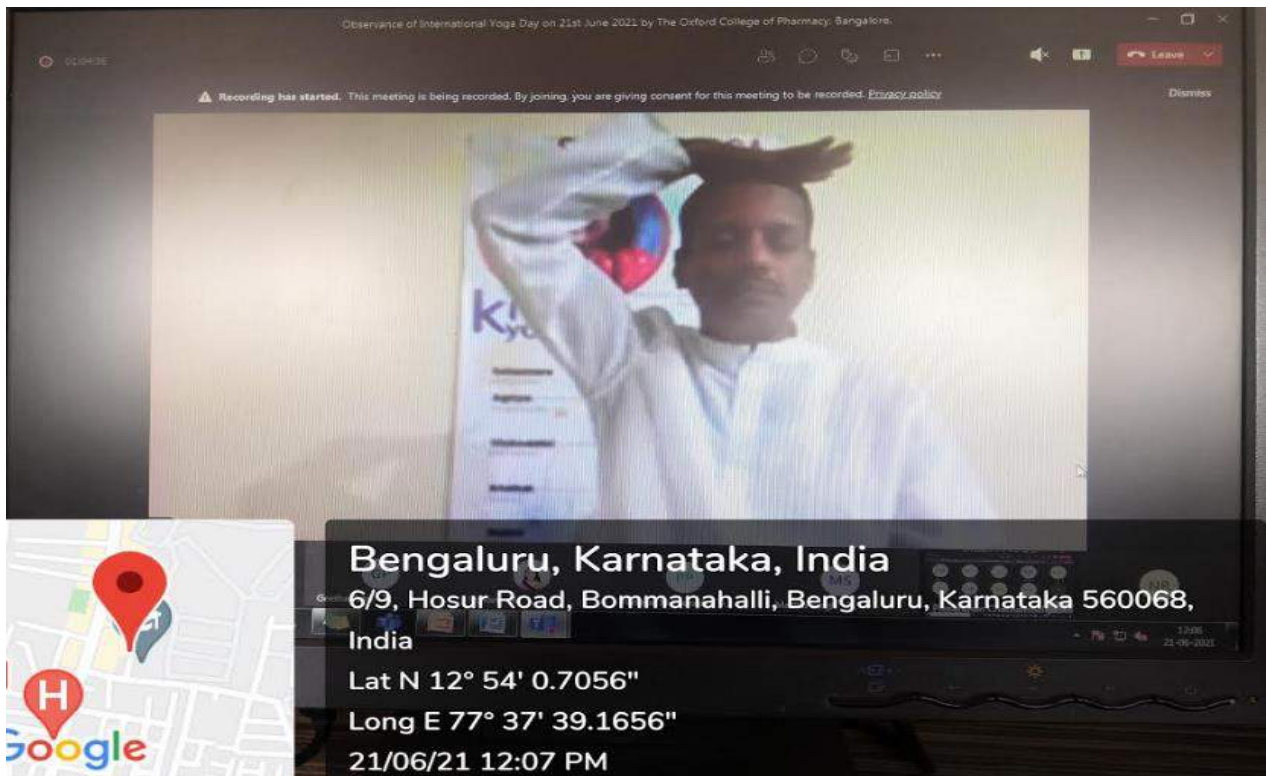

The content delivered in the webinar is as follows:

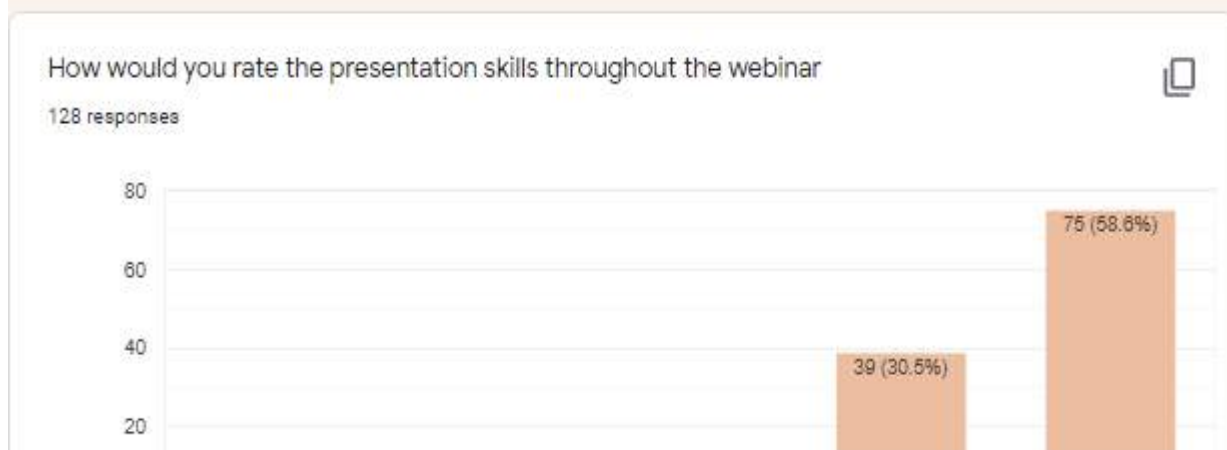
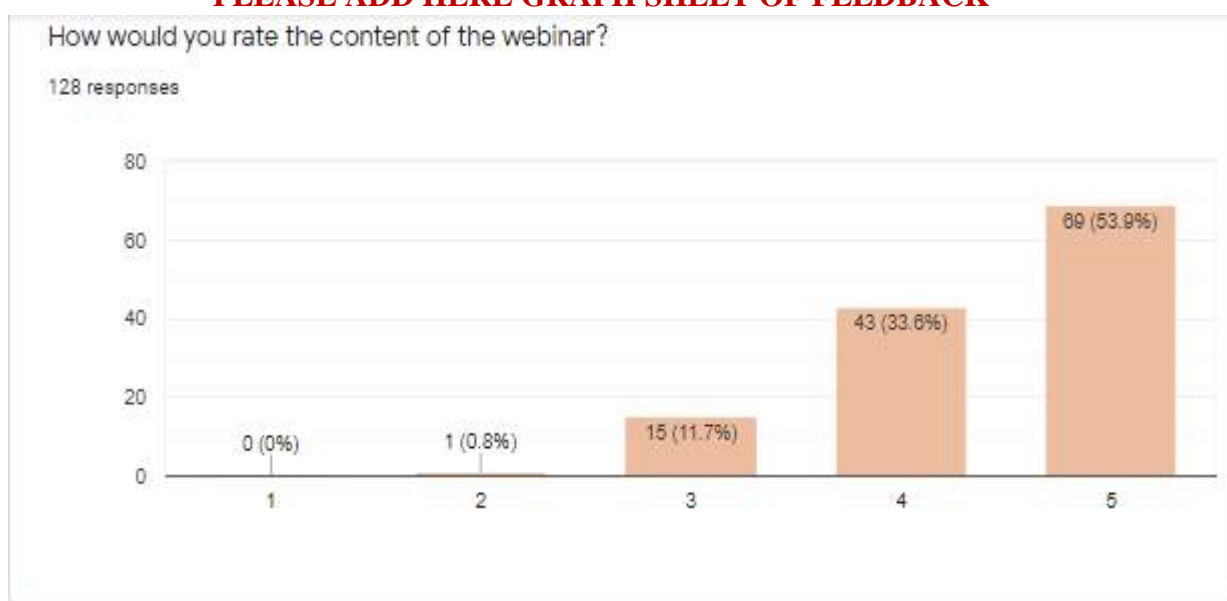

One may experience nausea or loss of appetite during periods. Having small meals is a better idea. However, one should not skip meals as well.



The content delivered in the webinar is as follows:

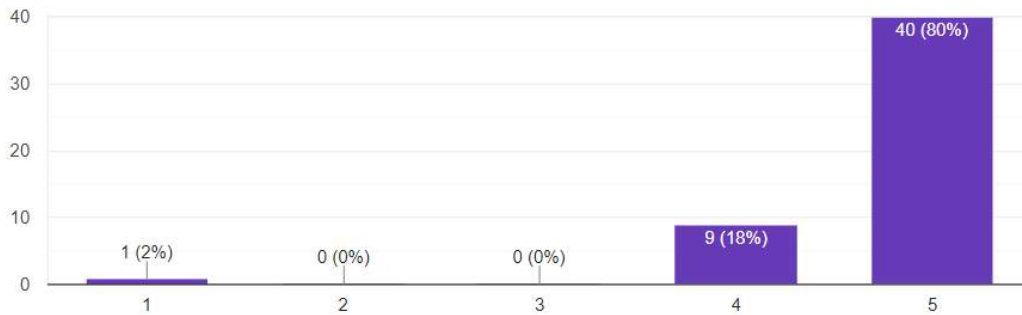
