

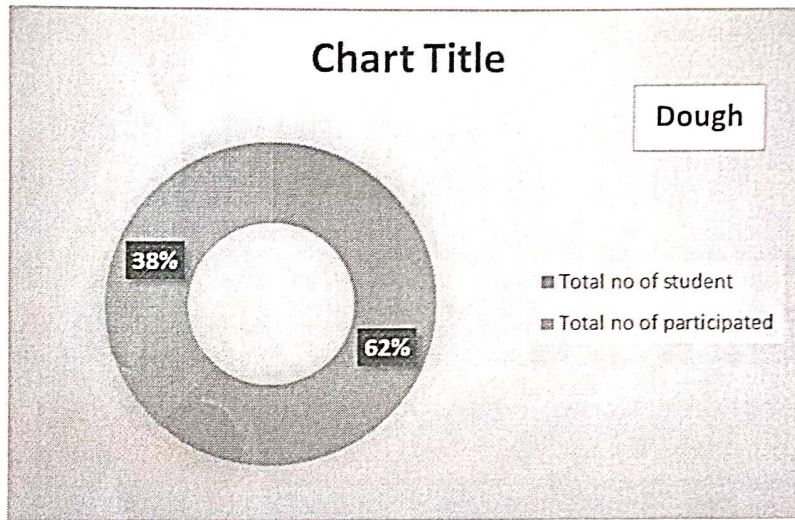

The total percentage of students taken part is 62 %



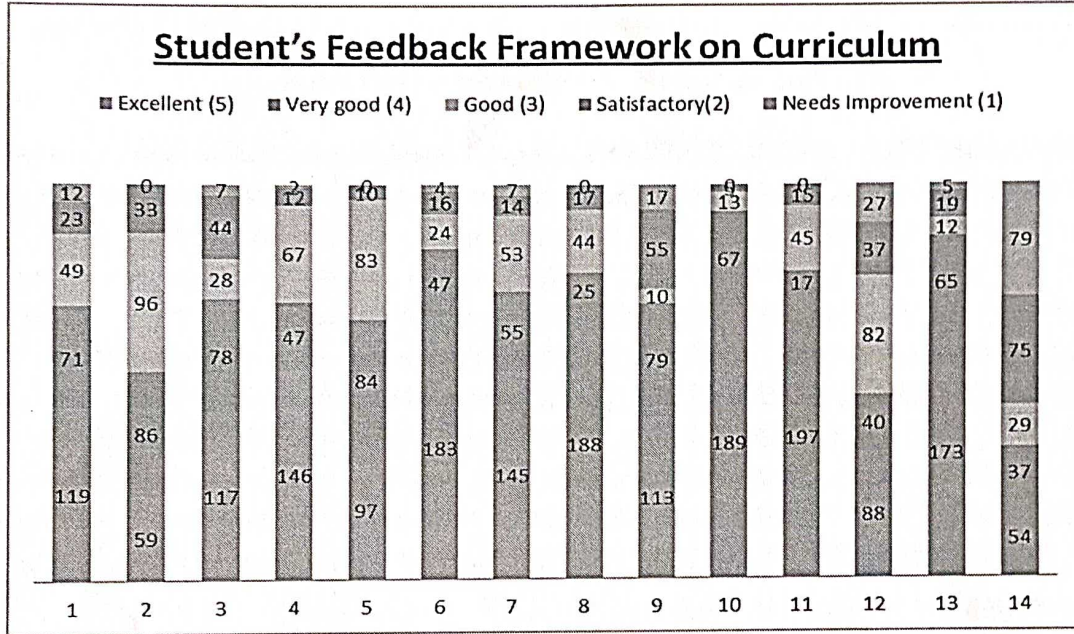

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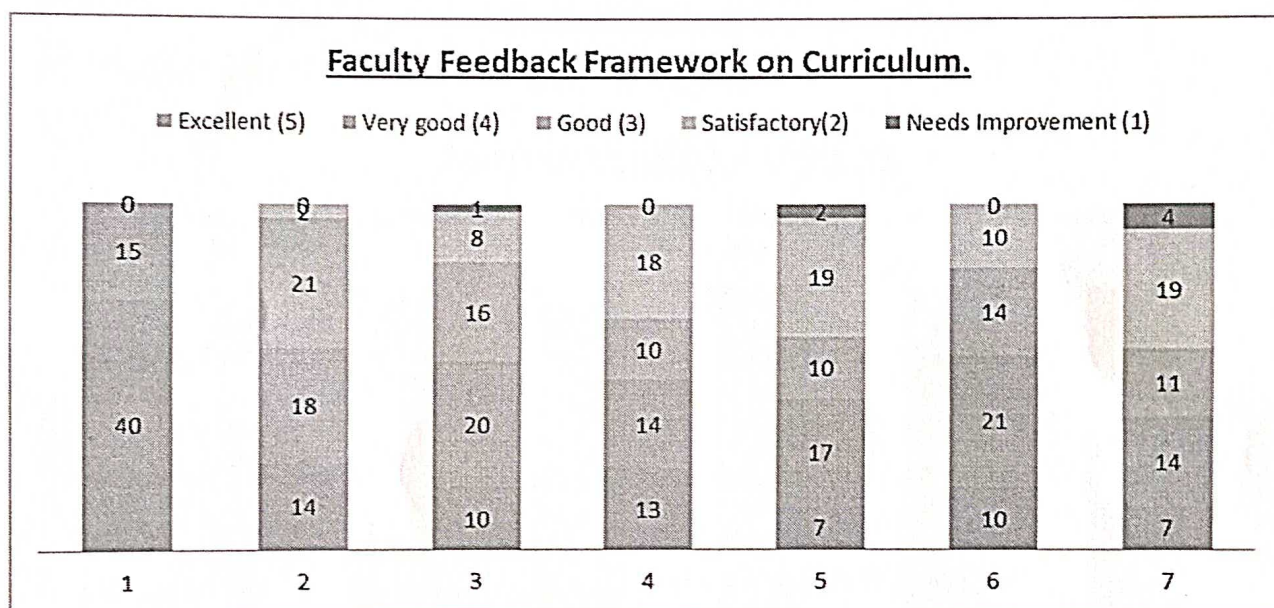

- Frequent seminars/webinars should be conducted from industry persons for the students to get well versed with recent trends.

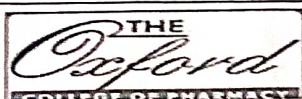

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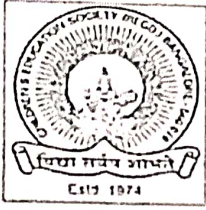

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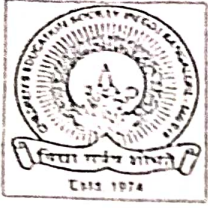
