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
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
During the year 2022-23 the feedback is collected from students and the analysis report is as follows:

1. The central grivenances redressal committee have to be more active in addressing the issues if any arises by the students in the sessional examination.








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

- 2. Addition of new and revised reference books for the reference section.






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
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3. E-books purchase should be promoted

1. Any problems in the lab, common washrooms, classrooms, benches, chairs, tables etc., should be addressed by the central grievances committee.







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- 1. Conduct more number of research meetings and seminars, journal club.

- 3. Encourage students to participate in campaign for public awareness regarding the prevalent problems.







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- 1. Purchase of more number of glassware's yearly.

1. Motivate students to participate in extra-curricular activities that is being organised by our college and actively involved in inter-college competitions.







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1. Faculty are required to compulsorily update the juno lesson plan every day after the class taken
