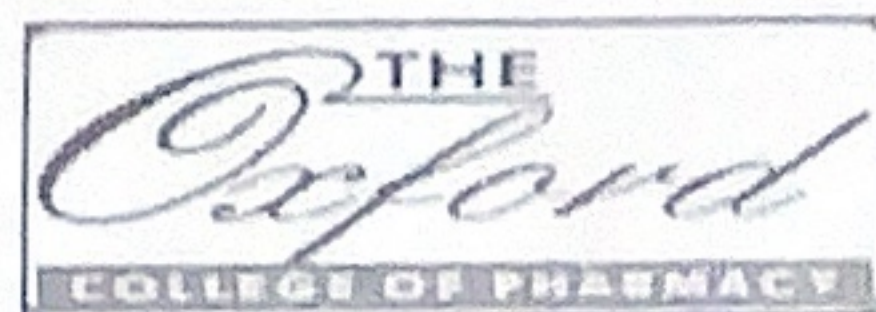

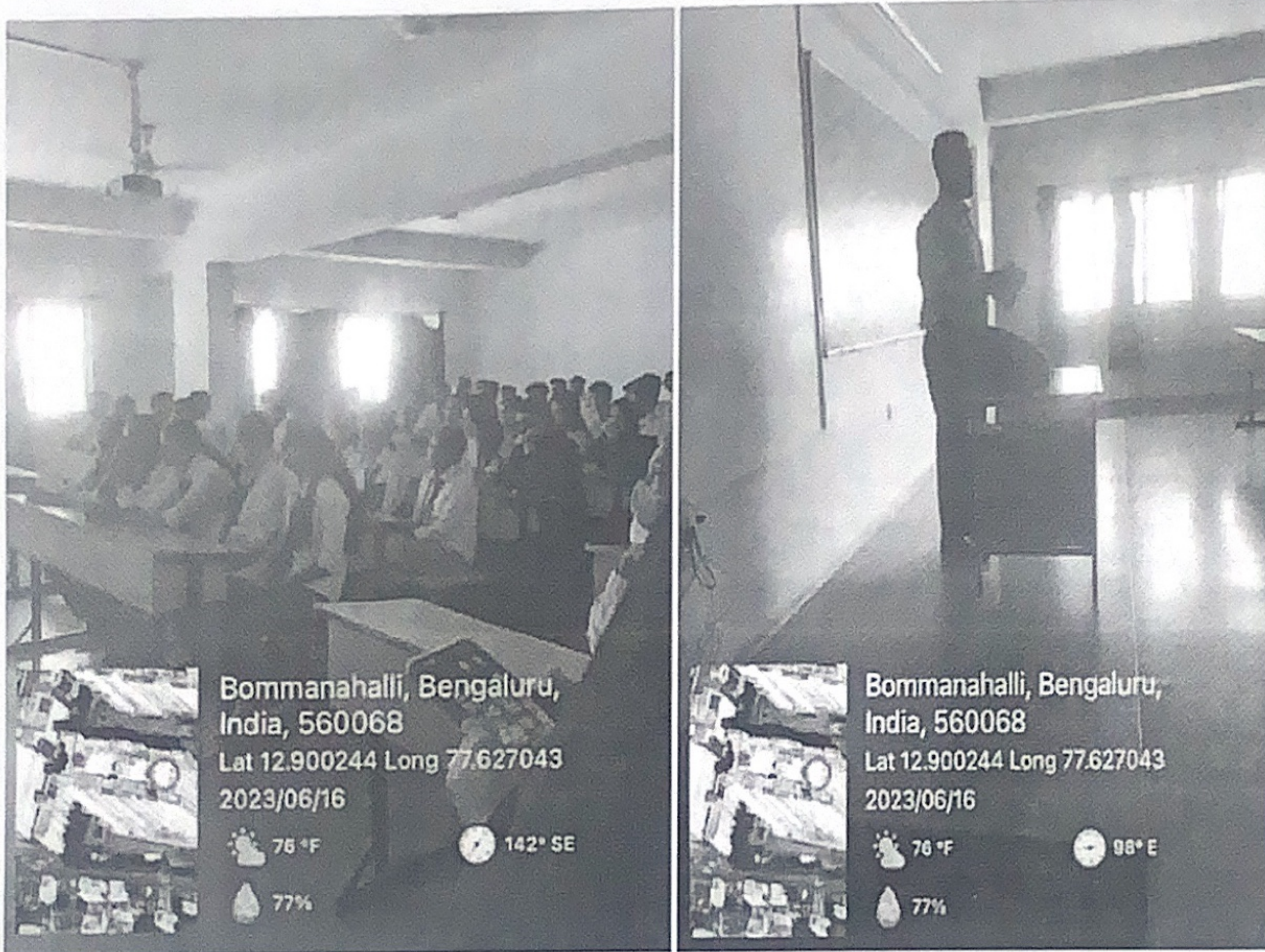

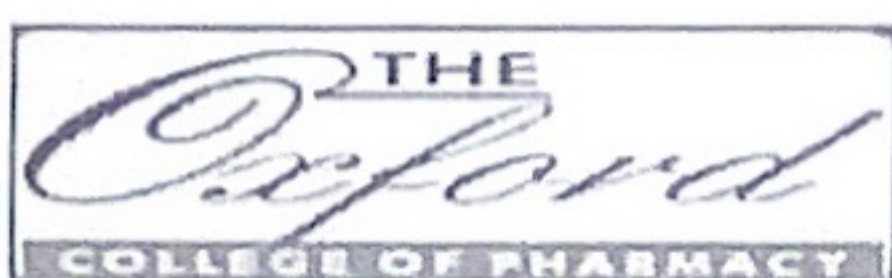

OUT COME OF THE PROGRAMME

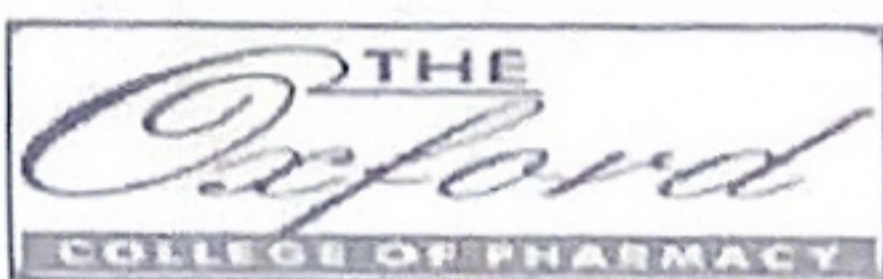
