Few students prepared posters and the enthusiasm among them waving the Indian flag truly shows the proud feeling of a patriotic citizen.



PREAMBLE:

Rashtriya Ekta Diwas or National Unity Day was introduced by the government of India in 2014 to pay tribute to great man who unified the country. While declaring October 31 as National Unity Day, the government said in an official statement that this occasion "will provide an opportunity to reaffirm the inherent strength and resilience of our nation to withstand the actual and potential threats to the unity, integrity, and security of our country."

THE PROGRAM DELIVERED AS FOLLOWS:

The program was started with a welcome note by Ms Liji Joy, Programme organizer followed by the inaugural address from Dr Padmaa M Paarakh, Principal, The Oxford College of Pharmacy.

Dr. Parthasarathy G, HOD, Department of Pharmacy Practice, was invited to talk about National Unity Day /Rashtriya Ekta Diwas. The birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel—the first home minister of Independent India—is celebrated as National Unity Day or Rashtriya Ekta Diwas. Vallabhbhai Jhaverbhai Patel also dubbed as 'Sardar Patel' was born on October 31, 1875, into a landowning family of the Leva Patidar caste.

Sardar Patel achieved the incredible feat of persuading almost every single one of the 565 self-governing princely states, that had been released from British suzerainty, to accede to the Union of India. For his commitment to the national integration of the newly independent country, Sardar Patel earned the sobriquet "Iron Man of India".

The event was organized by the Department of Pharmacy Practice in Room No.505 of The Oxford College of Pharmacy, Bangalore in between 11:30 to 12:30 PM headed by Dr. Padmaa M Paarakh, Principal, The Oxford College of Pharmacy.

A Pledge was taken by the students headed by Dr Sripriya C, Asst Professor as follows- "I solemnly pledge that I dedicate myself to preserve the unity, integrity, and security of the nation and also strive hard to spread this message among my fellow countrymen. I take this pledge in the spirit of unification of my country which was made possible by the vision and actions of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. I also solemnly resolve to make my own contribution to ensure the internal security of my country."

National Policy on Education: Rajiv Gandhi introduced a National Policy on Education in 1986 to modernize higher education plans and promote intellectual growth.

Jawaharlal Navodaya Vidhyalaya System: Rajiv Gandhi founded a central-government-based institution namely Jawaharlal Navodaya Vidhyalaya System in 1986 for the upliftment of the rural section of the society providing them free residential education from 6th to 12th class.

Telecommunications Development: Due to his efforts, MTNL (Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited) was established in 1986 and also created public call offices (PCOs) for spreading telephones in rural areas. 





PREAMBLE

The Oxford College of Pharmacy, Bengaluru, IQAC, organized "ZERO DISCRIMINATION DAY 2023" with an aim to educate our staffs and students about the zero discrimination. The program was conducted on March 1st 2023. The theme of the Programme was "SAVE LIVES- DECRIMINALISATION".

Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/Aids (UNAIDS) is highlighting how the decriminalization of key populations and people living with HIV saves lives and helps advance the end of the AIDS pandemic. Criminal laws targeting key populations and people living with HIV violate people's human rights, exacerbate the stigma people face and put people in danger by creating barriers to the support and services they need to protect their health.

In 2021, the world set ambitious law reform targets to remove criminal laws that are undermining the HIV response and leaving key populations behind. Recognizing decriminalization as a critical element in the response, countries made a commitment that by 2025 less than 10% of countries would have punitive legal and policy environments that affect the HIV response.

In fact, today there are 134 countries explicitly criminalizing or otherwise prosecuting HIV exposure, non-disclosure or transmission; 20 countries criminalize and/or prosecute transgender persons; 153 countries criminalize at least one aspect of sex work; and 67 countries now criminalize consensual same-sex sexual activity, according to UNAIDS. In addition, 48 countries still place restrictions on entry into their territory for people living with HIV, while 53 countries report that they require mandatory HIV testing, for example for marriage certificates or for performing certain professions. 106 countries report requiring parental consent for adolescents to access HIV testing.

Criminalization drives discrimination and structural inequalities. It robs people of the prospect of healthy and fulfilling lives. And it holds back the end of AIDS.

SYMPTOMS OF ASTHMA TO LOOK OUT FOR

- · Wheezing, a whiatling or squeaky sound when breathing
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty in breathing
- · Chest tightness or pain.
- · Chronic coughing especially at night or early morning
- · Rapid breathing or panting.
- · Trouble sleeping.
- · Patique or tiredness due to difficulty of breathing.
- · Auxiety or panic due to sudden onset of symptoms.



HOW TO USE AN INHALER

- · STEP 1: Remove the cap
- The cap is a small covering located over the mouthpiece of the infinler to prevent foreign objects from getting in the infialer. Pull the cap to remove it and set it in a safe place. An uncapped inhaler can pick up germs and debris, which you will then pump into your lungs.
- · Make sure that you don't lose your cap while you're using your inhaler.



FIRST AID FOR ASTHMA

- · Step 1: Sit the person upright
- · Be colm and reasouring
- · Po not leave them alone.
- · Step 2: Give 4 separate puffs of blue/grey reliever puffer
- · Shake the puffer.
- · But I puff into the spacer.
- · Get the person to take 4 breaths from the spacer.
- Repeat until 4 putfs lawe been taken. (If you don't have a spacer, give 1 putf as they take
 1 slow, deep breath and hold breath for as long as confortable. Repeat until all putfs are
 taken.)
- · Remember: Shake, 1 puff. 4 breaths.



PREAMBLE

Antibiotics are essential medicines that fight infections caused by bacteria in humans and animals by either killing the bacteria or making it difficult for them to grow and multiply. However, their misuse and unnecessary prescription can lead to side effects and contribute to antibiotic resistance, which is a significant threat to public health.

CONTENT

An awareness program was held on 8/05/2023 at The Oxford College of Pharmacy, organised by Ms. Nagalakshmi, Department of Pharmacology and speech delivered by Dr Noopur Srivastava, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacology, discussed in depth about awareness on antibiotic usage. And explained thoroughly regarding antibiotic resistance and its effect on public health. There were around 50 participants.

Antibiotics are potent drugs that cure certain illnesses and, when taken correctly, may save lives. They either prevent germs from multiplying or kill them. Bacteria are normally killed by the immune system before they grow and produce symptoms. White blood cells (WBCs) destroy dangerous germs; even if symptoms appear, the immune system is normally able to manage and fight off the illness. However, there are occasions when the quantity of hazardous germs is enormous, and the immune system is unable to eliminate them all. Antibiotics can in handy in this situation.

Penicillin was the first antibiotic. Penicillin-based medicines, such as ampicillin, amoxicillin, and penicillin G, are still accessible and have been used for many years to treat a range of illnesses.

As well as they discussed about the side effects of antibiotic usage. The amount of antibiotics to which our planet's microbes have been exposed over the previous half-century might be in the millions of metric tons. Antibiotic overuse has resulted in selection pressure and the evolution of multidrug resistant superbugs. In India, the situation is considerably worse because antibiotics may be acquired over the counter and, more recently, through internet shopping without a legitimate doctor's prescription.





You may need to take antibiotics for some bacterial infections. For example, you might not need them for many sinus infections. Taking antibiotics when they're not needed won't help you, and they can have side effects.

Strategies to limit the development of resistance are urgently needed, and one of them is educating the general public about prudent antibiotic use. 

If the same medicine misused, the patients may get resistance to the antibiotic and may lead further complications to the patients. - Across the globe around 3.5 million hectares of land are converted for tobacco growing each year.
 Growing tobacco also contributes to deforestation of 200 000 hectares a year.
- Tobacco growing is resource intensive and requires heavy use of pesticides and fertilizers, which contribute to soil degradation.
- Land used for growing tobacco then has a lower capacity for growing other crops, such as food, since tobacco depletes soil fertility.
- Compared with other agricultural activities such as maize growing and even livestock grazing,
 tobacco farming has a far more destructive impact on ecosystems as tobacco farmlands are more prone to desertification.
