Guidelines for authors

Please ensure your submission meets the conference's strict guidelines for accepting scholarly papers, the manuscripts should normally be less than 3000 words typed in double-space or printed in 12-points Arial font on 8.5"x11" (A-4 size papers) with 1.5-inch margin on all four sides.

- ▶ The cover page should contain title, designation, official address, contact address, phone/fax numbers and e-mail address of all authors. Also, a non-mathematical abstract of about 200 words should be submitted along with manuscript. Reference should be placed at the end of the manuscript.
- ▶ The list should mention only those sources cited in the text of the manuscript, The paper will be reviewed and only selected papers will be allowed for the seminar presentation. For accepted papers, one of the authors is expected to present the paper online.
- ▶ Please note that **E-certificate** will be issued only to registered authors, Selected papers will be published in Vidyaniketan Journal of Management & Research, Selected papers will be published in Vidyaniketan Journal of Management & Research with ISSN 2320-3951 for free of cost and in UGC Care listed Journal with additional cost.
