## REPORT ON SOCIAL WORK ANNUAL RURAL CAMP 2025

### About the Annual Rural Camp:

The Department of Social Work, The Oxford College of Arts, Bangalore, organised the Annual Rural Camp 2025 from 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 at Bendagodu Village, Uyyamballi Grama Panchayath, KanakapurTq, Bangalore South District as a part of curriculum for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester MSW Students for 10 Days.

Every day the students had various scheduled activities from morning till night starting from Yoga and Exercises to equip the students mentally for whole day tasks and responsibilities, followed by Shramadan in the different selected areas of the village. From the second day, the students, under the guidance of faculty coordinators, organised various Community Awareness Programmes on themes of participatory rural appraisal, Menstrual Health, Rural Employment and Livelihood Schemes, Child Development and Women Empowerment, Legal Awareness, Family Counseling. Health camps held under this programme included The Medical Check Camp, Dental Check-up Camp, Veterinary Camp. Sapling planting Drive was organised to afforest the village. The village was assessed by a Survey based on socio economic, education and health parameters. Games for villagers were also conducted by the students as per the camp schedule. There were the cultural programmes, held every evening by the students with the motto of infotainment to disseminate the time worth information through entertainment. The cultural programs were directed to create awareness on health, education, social problems and ignorance in the minds of the village people. The daily camp evaluation for tracking the shortcomings to improvise the tasks in next days was conducted every night.

## Detailed Report

### Day 1: 23/07/2025 Inaugural Programme

Social work Annual Rural Camp 2025 was inaugurated by Mr. V D Chandru, President, Uyyamballi Grama Panchayath by lighting the lamp. Mr. Chandru thanked the Oxford College of Arts and assured of extending all round support for organizing the rural camp for 10 days in the village. The programme was presided over by Mr. H K Ravi, former president of Uyyamballi Grama Panchayath and a native of the Bendagodu Village. The Chief Guest present in the programme were Mr. Ramesh, member of Bendagodu Ward, Mrs. Saraswathi Bai, Chairperson, MPCS Dairy Bendagodu, Kumar Naik, Villager, Mr. Soma Naik Former President GP Uyyamballi and Village Head, Mr. Mutthu Naik, Former Member Bendagodu Ward.

### Day 2: 24/07/2025 General Health Camp

On 24<sup>th</sup> July 2025, the General Health Camp was organised at the Community Library in the village by The Oxford Medical College and Hospital, Bangalore. Approximately 80 villagers attended the camp and made the organization of camp worthwhile. The students volunteered wholeheartedly in organizing Health check-up camp. They also volunteered in intimating, mobilizing, registering and guiding the villagers to take up necessary care and medicines for better health.

### Day 3: 25/07/2025 – Dental Check Up camp

On 25<sup>th</sup> July Dental Check Up camp was held at Community Library in the village by The Oxford Dental College and Hospital, Bangalore. Approximately 40 villagers utilized the dental check-up camp by availing the given service by the Dental College team. The social work students volunteered very well in the camp by involving themselves in tasks such as inviting the villagers by visiting every household, bringing elders to camp site and guiding the beneficiaries of health camp about the medical prescriptions and next care plan to be made as directed by the doctor.

### Day 4: 26/07/2025 - Participatory Rural Appraisal

On 25<sup>th</sup> July, Participatory Rural Appraisal was held in the village to analyze the existing rural problems in the village and sensitize the villagers about the potential factors prevailing in the area which could help in problem solving process in the community. Ms. Milan, Head Social Welfare Department, Fame India and Mr. Siddaraju, Social Welfare Officer, Fame India, the resource persons for the programme, coordinated and guided the students to activate the tasks of Participative Rural Appraisal system. Training of the students on PRA strategy, mobilizing the community by home Visits, Social and Resource Mapping, Participative Problem analysis and Resolution Taking were the key aspects of whole programme. The resource person threw light on various livelihood schemes available for the youth in rural areas and procedure to avail the benefits. Villagers made the program useful with interactive session.

In the evening, an Agriculture Awareness programme was organized for the villagers. Mr. Asgar, Nodal Agriculture Officer, Dodda Alahalli, Kanakapur created awareness among the villagers on various benefits and schemes available for farmers and ways to avail it. The villagers utilized the programme with interactive participation.

**Day 7: 29/07/2025 -Community Awareness Programme on Women and Child Development**

On 29<sup>th</sup> July, the Community Awareness Programme was on Women and Child Development by Mr. Narayan, CDPO, Kanakapur. 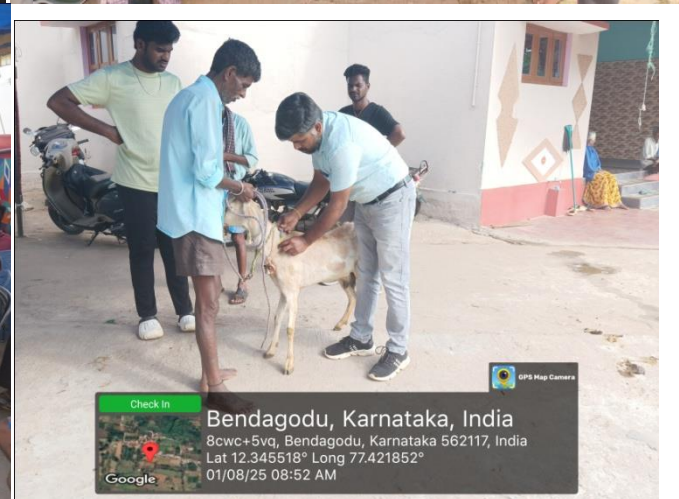

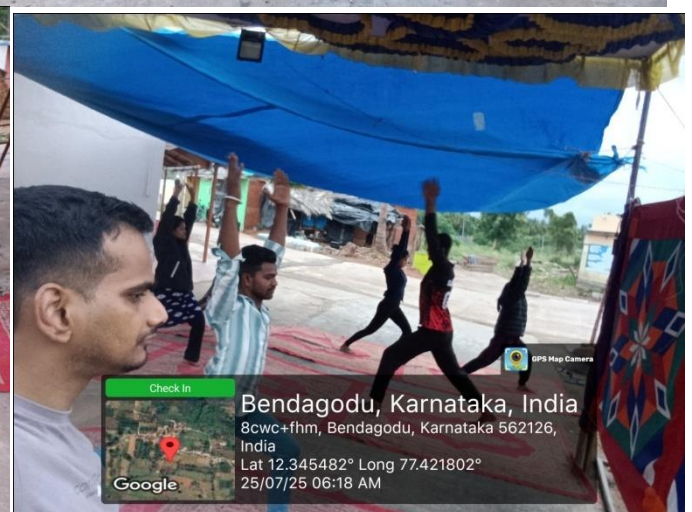
