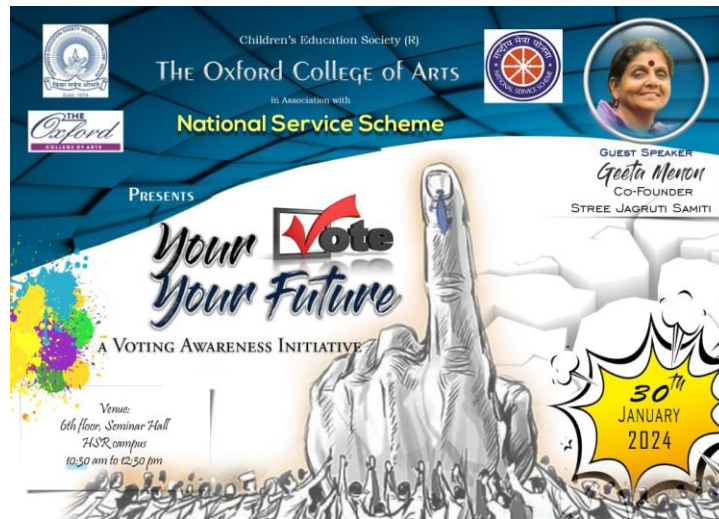


"Your Vote, Your Future"
