PREAMBLE

The Department of Pharmacognosy conducted the seminar on “Intellectual Property Rights” for the students and teaching faculties. Dr. Padmaa M Paarakh, Professor and HOD, The Oxford College of Pharmacy, Bangalore delivered the lecture. There were 16 participants.

The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:

The speaker began the session addressing on the seminar topic- “**Intellectual Property Rights**”. It consists of a set of rights that grants exclusive ownership for their innovative creations. These rights encourage innovation, creativity and fair competition. There are two main categories in intellectual property viz., copyrights and industrial property. Copyrights includes literature and art-associated works whereas industrial property includes trademarks, patents, industrial designs and trade secrets.

The legal parameters surrounding intellectual property is complex and varies across jurisdictions. For protection of intellectual property, several legislations have been passed in India.

In academic institutions, establishment of an IPR Cell is essential for management of research projects, collaborations etc., which possess intellectual property. The key functions of IPR cell includes safeguarding academic staff rights and ensuring research project findings are properly protected and made commercialized when necessary.

IPR encourages inventors with incentive to invest time, effort and resources in developing new ideas and products so thereby which they can get the benefits of their inventions. It prevents unauthorised use, reproduction or distribution of the inventions by others. IPR promotes research and development by providing protection to new technologies, and advancements in research. Additionally, IPR enhances competitiveness of businesses by offering protection to brands, innovations, trade secrets thereby enabling differentiation between themselves in the market and maintaining competitive environment.



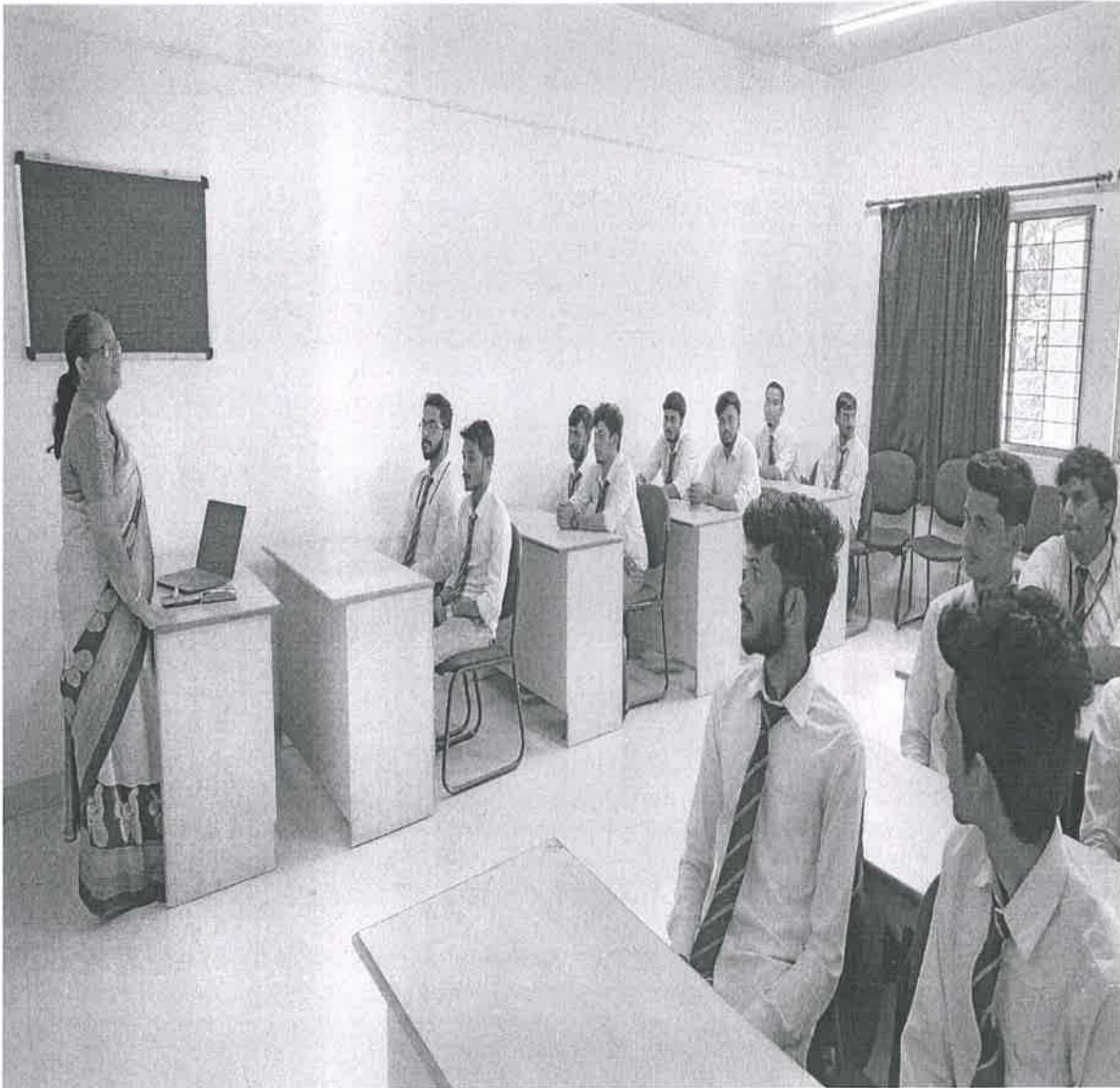

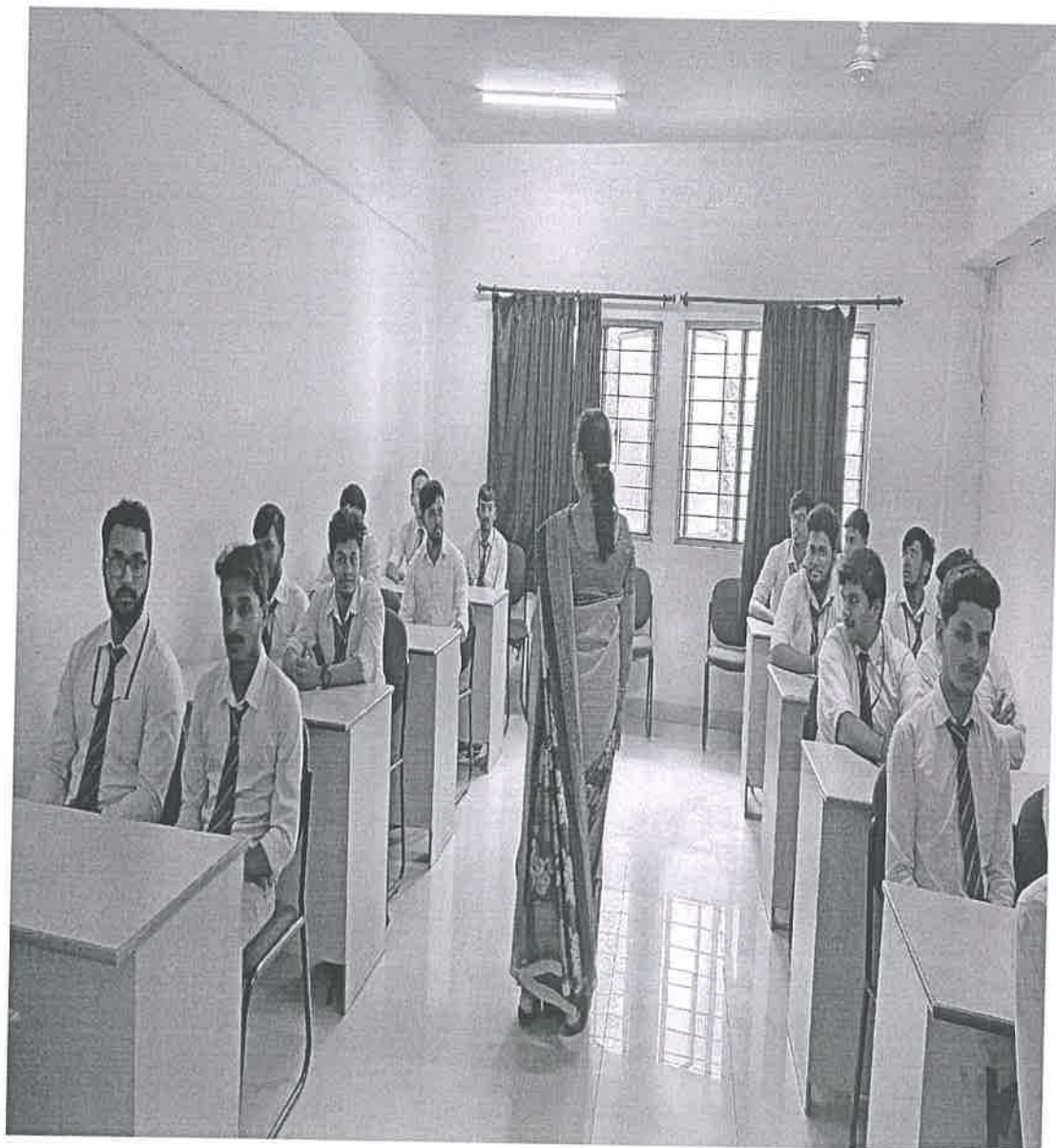

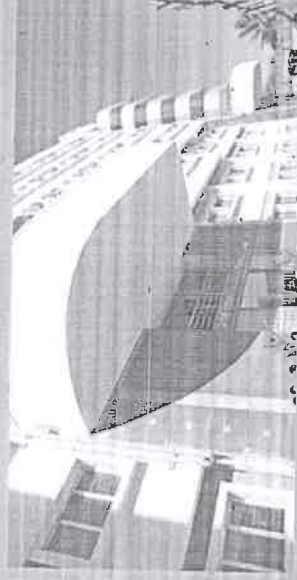

The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:

The speaker began the session addressing on the seminar topic- **Methods and Techniques in Research Methodology**. Research methods refers to the specific procedures used for collecting and analyzing data. Developing research method is a part of your research design. Two key decisions to be kept in mind while planning the research methods viz., how you will collect data and how you will analyze the data. Collecting the data could be quantitative or qualitative in the form of words or numbers, primary or secondary- where you will collect the data yourself or you will use data that has already been collected by others, and descriptive or experimental, where you will record the measurements as it is or you will carry out an experiment.

Later, the speaker addressed for analysing the quantitative data, where using statistical methods to identify relationship between variables and for analysing the qualitative data, thematic analysis is used. Research methods includes an experiment, or it could be survey, interview, observation, or a case study. Research methods serve many purposes like identifying research problems, developing hypotheses, collection and analysis of data, and arriving at conclusions with enhanced understanding.

Additionally, the speaker emphasised the following situations in which the research methods can be used like for investigation of a problem, collection of data on a particular subject, in evaluating effectiveness of a programme through which the whether the programme is able to meet its objectives, in exploring new area. Research methods are used in numerous fields to carry out investigation, its analysis and find solution to the research question. The speaker further added that usage of research methods offers benefits like objectivity, replicability, generalizability, precision, efficiency and innovation.
