PREAMBLE

The protection of physical and intangible property is the focus of intellectual property rights (IPRs). It acknowledges and recognizes inventors and contributors for their research, designs, discoveries, innovations, and so on. In a market-driven economy, intellectual property protection is critical for getting a slight edge in terms of technical advancements and generating faster economic development. Some common forms of IPR includes patents, copyrights, trademarks, and trade secrets. One can go for registering the IPR, he or she can protect the ideas from infringement and ensure that you have the legal authority on your inventions. To protect new ideas, one has to file for patent protection, usage of confidentiality agreements when discussing about ideas with others, or licensing the patenting idea to a company.

Additionally, IPR plays a vital role in nurturing innovation, creativity and economic development. IPR encourages inventors with incentive to invest time, effort and resources in developing new ideas and products so thereby which they can get the benefits of their inventions. It prevents unauthorized use, reproduction or distribution of the inventions by others. IPR promotes research and development by providing protection to new technologies, and advancements in research. IPR has grown in relevance in all areas of socioeconomic growth. It assists in the understanding of patentability criteria in depth and the viability of the patent.

She also explained about how patents can support inventors and improve lives in many ways- they recognize and reward inventors for successful inventions, when new technology comes onto the market, society as a whole stand to benefit, help further finance technological research and development, help to spark new ideas and promote new inventions










