The general objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the intellectual development on both campuses. Thus, The Oxford Dental College and The Oxford College of Pharmacy have agreed that in support of their mutual interests in the field of education and research.

e) Conduct study tours, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.

2. Facilitate the exchange of undergraduate students and post-graduate students. Such exchanges may take place for a short period (or at least one term or semester). The academic standing of such students shall be determined by the host college. Accreditation for the academic work carried out by an undergraduate student during the period of study at the host college will be at the discretion of both the colleges.

3. The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both colleges.

4. Academic members of staff and other personnel of one partner institution may spend periods not normally exceeding one academic year in the other partner institution. In supporting such an arrangement the home institution undertakes to continue the salary of the participant. All other financial matters, including travel costs, are subject to individual negotiation, and will normally be the responsibility of the persons involved and their home institution.

5. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.

6. The Oxford Dental College shall not hold The Oxford College of Pharmacy liable for any damage that is caused, whether directly or indirectly, by The Oxford Dental College. 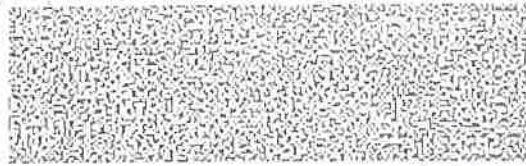

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PREAMBLE:

The Department of Pharmaceutical chemistry conducted a on-line guest lecture on "PLANT TISSUE CULTURE: BASIC CONCEPT AND APPLICATION" for the teaching faculties and students.

Plant tissue culture broadly refers to the *in vitro* cultivation of all plant parts under aseptic conditions. Any laboratory in which tissue culture techniques are performed must contain a number of basic facilities. These include areas for general washing and media preparation, sterilization, storage, aseptic transfer, observation/data collection, and environmentally controlled incubators or culture rooms. The most important work area is the culture transfer room where the core activity takes place.

THE COURSE CONTENT DELIVERED IS AS FOLLOWS:

The speaker of the session Prof. Ajay Sharma addressed on "PLANT TISSUE CULTURE: BASIC CONCEPT AND APPLICATION". There were 150 participants. Guest lecture has mainly focused on basic concepts and application of plant tissue culture. The speaker shared his magnificent knowledge and experience in the biotechnology area. Current research in plant tissue culture is highly focused on commercial applications such as crop improvement, secondary metabolite production, and various strategies for inducing genetic interference. Production of transgene and its stable expression through plant tissue culture supported by several genetic tools is again the most critical issue discussed nowadays. Incorporation of such genes produces stress tolerant plants with improved secondary metabolite production giving various real-life examples. He also talked about basic science field in biotechnology area, about root and shoot initiation, shoot from callus.

The guest lecture was further enlightened by the interesting questions answer session in the last which gave true colors to the guest lecture and gave chance to young innovations to speak their doubts regarding plant tissue culture types.

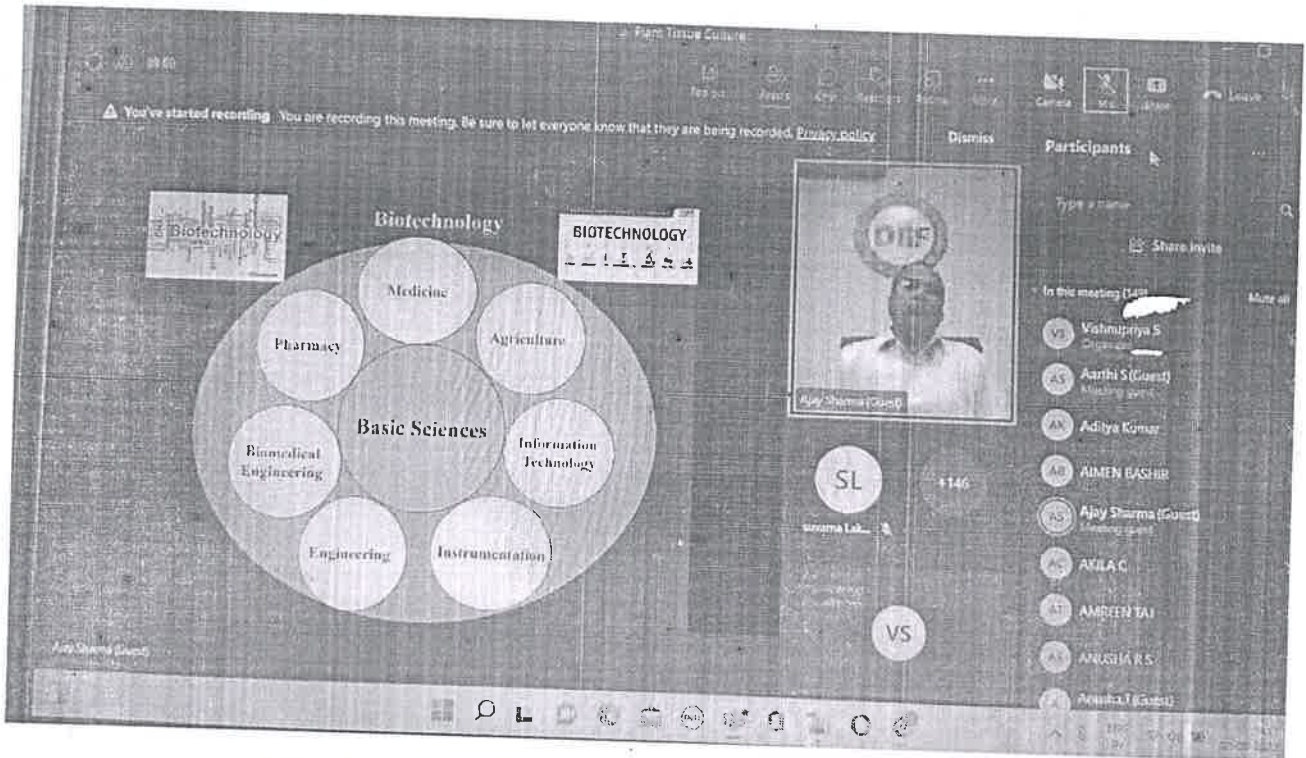
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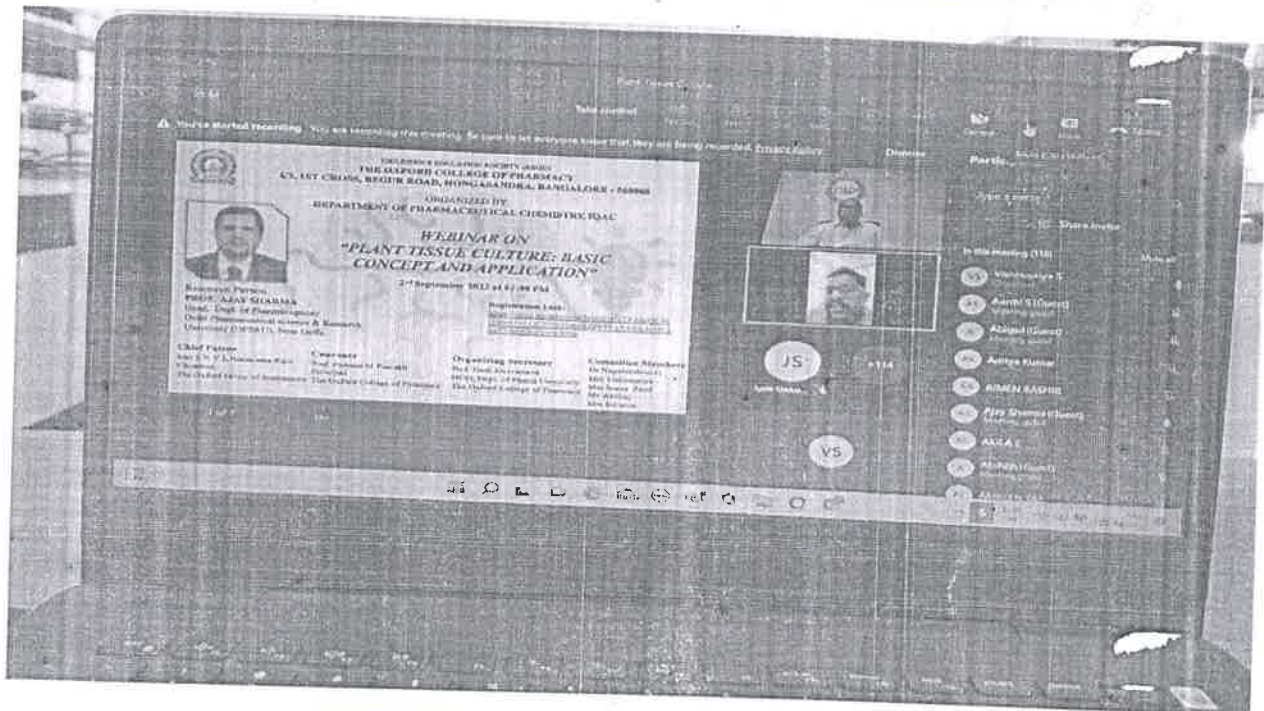

Prof. Ajay Sharma interacting with the participants in the online webinar

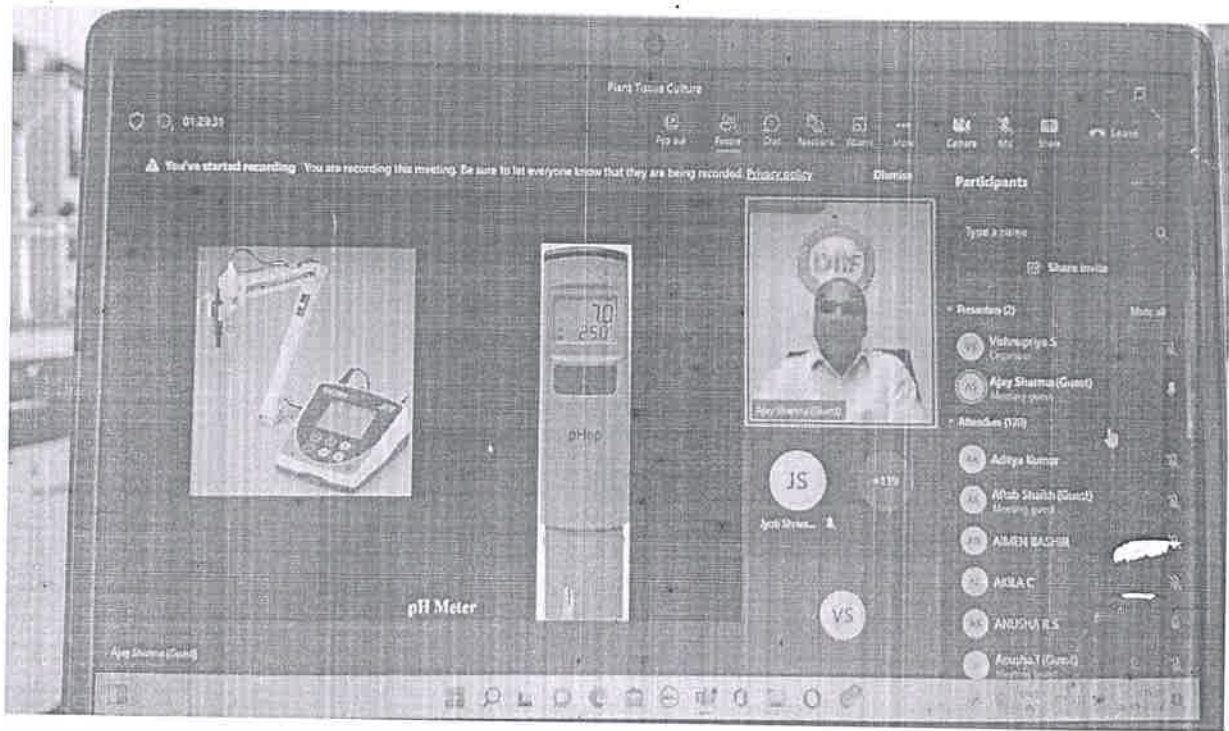


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Prof. Ajay Sharma explaining the usage of pH meter in the online webinar

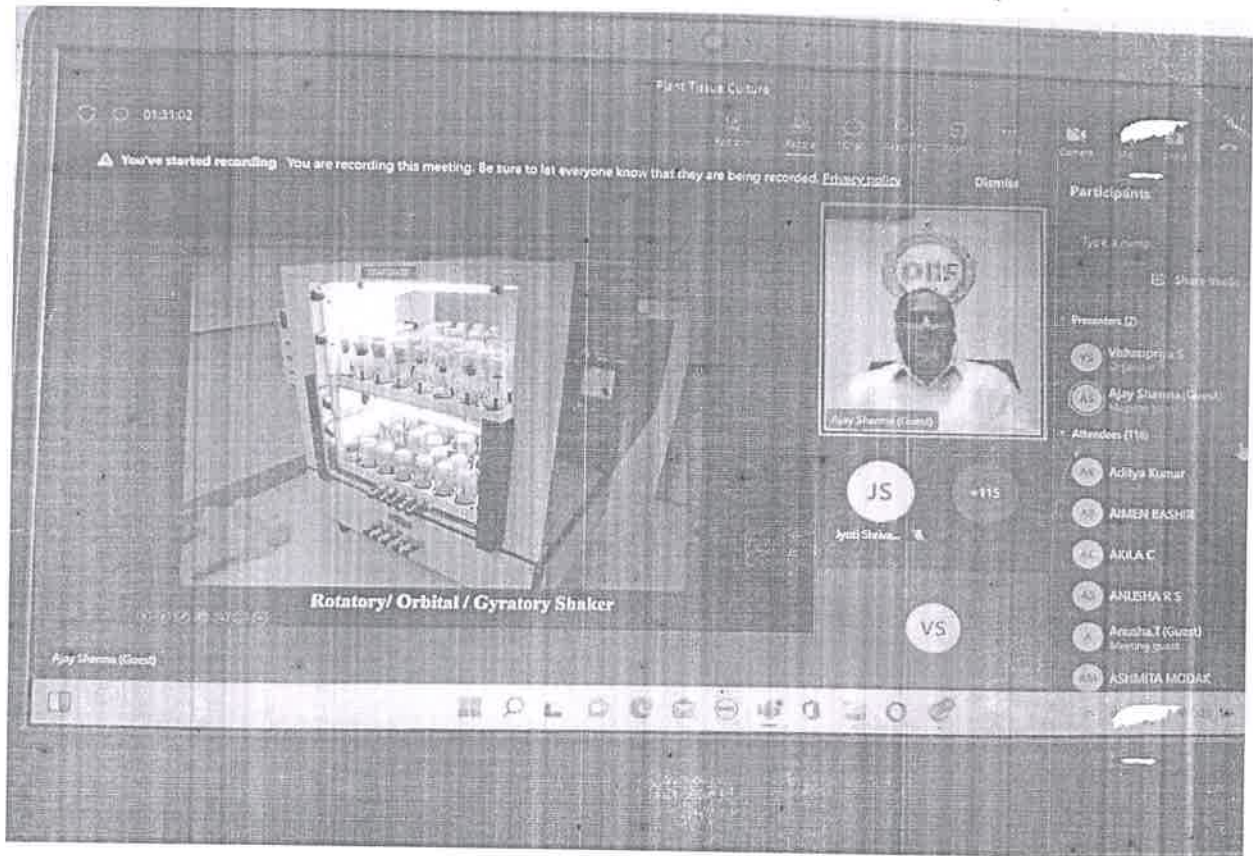


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Prof. Ajay Sharma explaining the usage of rotatory/Orbital/Gyrotory shaker in the online webinar

The Indian systems of medicine i.e., Siddha, Ayurveda & Unani mainly encompass herbal medicines along with herbo-mineral formulations. The speaker addressed the students regarding the emerging trends of herbal medicine because of their efficacy, safety and lesser side effects. The preparations are either as single herbs or as collections of herbs in composite formulae. Sir briefed about the various methods and methodology used during formulation of herbal drugs. He also emphasized on various challenges faced during the preparation of herbal drugs when compared to synthetic drugs. 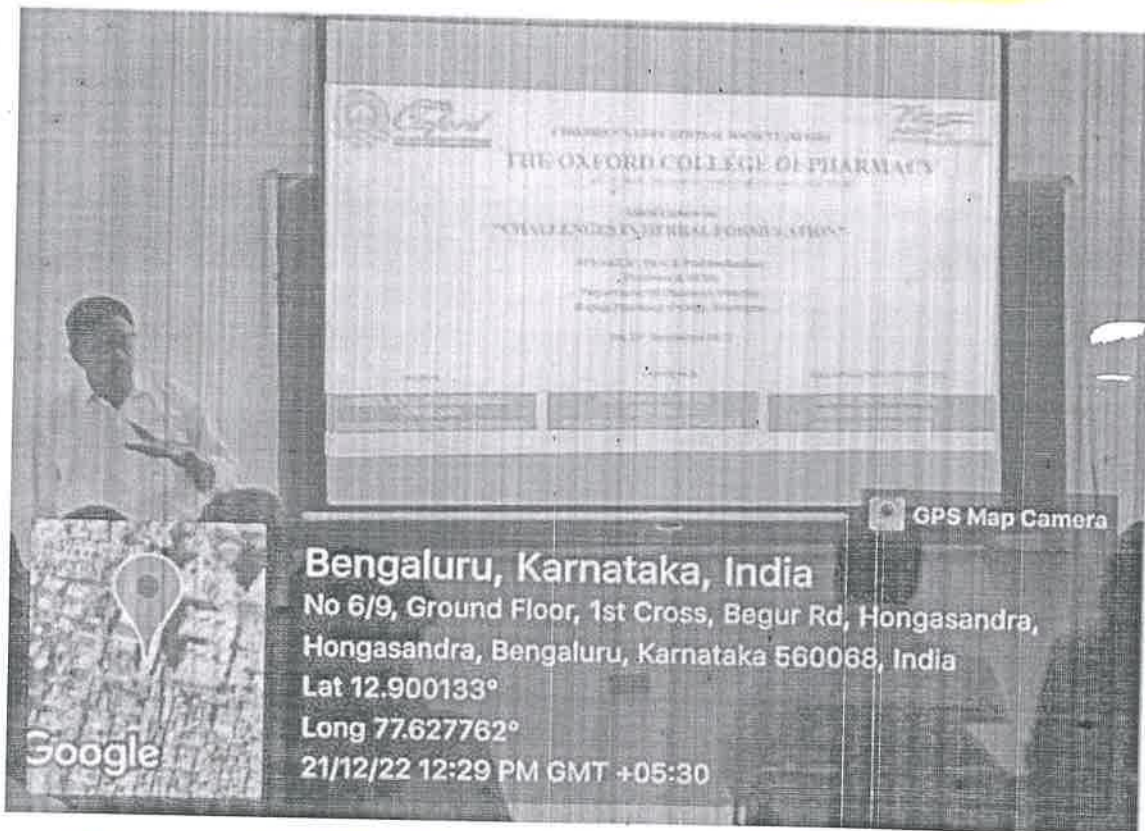

And

The Oxford College of Pharmacy at Hongasandra, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560068, being represented by Dr. Padmaa M. Paraakh, Principal, The Oxford College of Pharmacy, hereinafter referred to as "TOCP".

The term First Party and Second Party afore mentioned unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include their successors, subsidiaries, affiliates in office, authorized representatives.

The two parties to this Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") accept the following Terms and Conditions with a common intention of being legally bound on them.
