

### **The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:**

The resource person discussed in depth about Biostatistics is the application of statistical methods to medical, biological and public health related problems. Discussed regarding dependent variable, independent variable, application of sample size, types of significance tests, parametric and non parametric tests as well as special diagrams for clinical research.

In depth they discussed regarding sampling techniques, testing of hypothesis p- value, standard error and degrees of freedom, importance of statistical terms. Biostatistics simplifies mass of data, it facilitates for comparison, it measures the trend behaviour, it tests the hypothesis.

The major goal of the webinar is to know the Role of biostatistics in clinical medicine, It plays major role in the documentation of the medical history of diseases, their course of progression, variability between patients, their association with specific characteristics such as age and sex. In evaluating the merits of different kinds of procedures in surgery, radiation, physiotherapy etc, upon patients by following them up over a period of time.
