

### **PREAMBLE**

The current workshop aims at providing hands on training to young researchers who are working in the field of experimental pharmacology. The workshop covers basic experimental techniques such as handling of laboratory animals, routes of drug administration, blood collection techniques, surgical techniques, isolated tissue experiments, design of pre-clinical experiments, etc.
