QUALITY INITIATIVES

- 1. IQAC has initiated measures to strengthen the curriculum delivery by adopting innovative teaching learning pedagogies, stakeholder feedback is collected and upon analysis of the same Value-added courses to bridge industry academia connect.
- 2. The IQAC has taken initiative to strengthen CIE mechanism and has integrated multiple forms of assessment, As a result of the same there is an substantial improvement in the academic performance of the students and has achieved 100% pass percentage.
- 3. The IQAC shall be constantly monitoring the Mentor Mentee initiatives, so as to ensure Holistic development of the student, Faculty assesses the students and accordingly plan and organize mentoring activities. IQAC has strengthened the Career Counselling Cell of College, and has organized through Career counselling Cell various Skill development and capacity building initiatives.
- 4. The IQAC through the R& D committee of TOCP has encouraged all the staff and students to present & participate in Seminars & conferences. As a result of the same there was substantial increase in Participation in conferences and seminars. In line with this more than 50% of the faculty and few students have attended in programmes hosted by institution and organized by other colleges.
- 5. The IQAC in consultation with R & D committee has initiated measures to foster the research acumen and to strengthen the Research Culture to enhance the Quality of Publications. As a result of the same, a total of 39 quality publications are published in journals of repute.

TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS

The Oxford College of Pharmacy has strategic teaching learning process and has systematic methodology for progressing the activities. In an Academic calendar year, The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) meets twice to review the Teaching and Learning Process. Institutional IQAC is responsible for developing, coordinating and monitoring academic activities and their assessment to the effect of improvement in faculty teaching and student learning. Academic Director, HOD's and senior faculty members of the Institute gathers often for the meeting chaired by the head of the Institution.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell guides accordingly to initiate the professional activities by involving various departments and carries out internal audit for every department in each academic year. Institutional Academic Plan is confirmed well in advance before the semester commencement for all the courses. Institute has an effective internal communication system through physical circulars as well as through social media groups.

Outcomes:

IQAC intermittently assures the accomplishment of program outcomes of every course and program through...

- i) Course Files: A Course file is professional systematic compilation of each and every aspect pertaining to subject academic proceedings. As per the syllabus course file includes the details of topic completion, internal marks documentation and all other mandate aspects of the course. A detailed plan for every topic covered and the mapping of the exam questions with the course outcome is documented.
- ii) Evaluation-System: A typical evaluation system with regard to IQAC reforms is given by Input Based Information to Outcome Based Education (OBE) with direct procedures i.e., teaching-learning process and Indirect procedures i.e., sessional exams, lab internal, external and RGUHS exams (University examinations) exams using various assessment tools. Evaluation procedure for Outcome Based Education: The procedure of evaluation for OBE is as follows:

- 1. Sessional Examinations (Theory): Two Sessional Examinations are conducted for B. Pharm and M. Pharm students in each semester and three Sessional Examinations are conducted for Pharm.D & Pharm.D (PB) students as per the university norms. The Sessional Question Papers are mapped to the respective COs and scrutinized by Question Paper Scrutinizing Committee.
- 2. Sessional Examinations (Practical): Sessional Practical Examination includes evaluation of laboratory skills through answering synopsis, performance of Major and Minor experiment followed by viva-voce by institute faculty.
